University Report (2022-2023)

Reflecting upon the major developments of the academic year August 2022 to July 2023, this Annual Report takes stock of the progress made by the university in this time frame with reference to student records as well as architectural growth, academic accolades and policy frameworks. An integral part of the University's efforts in the aftermath of the online education phase has been to facilitate the students in relearning classroom etiquettes and in their resuming a regularity of the uniform life. As we have all adapted in numerous ways to live in this post-Covid world, it is my pleasure to report that we have been able to build upon the pillars erected by the previous years.

The fifth annual report of The Assam Royal Global University makes an introspective assessment putting three major areas of focus under the lens: Academic Excellence, Institutional Growth, and Partnership. The objective of this account is to reveal to us the potential of growth even as we acknowledge the steady progression. There has been a steady growth in all the areas of the institutional development, mainly research and projects, student enrollment and university events. RGU now offers 130 programs, across 42 departments consisting of undergraduate, postgraduate, integrated, diploma and doctoral degree under 24 schools. The last academic year saw a commendable growth in the campus infrastructure in terms of classroom space, laboratories, instruments, library, sports arena. The university has established an Optometry Lab, Biosciences Research Laboratory, a well equipped Physiotherapy Laboratory and the Royal Diagnostic Lab. Our students have not just performed academically well but have also excelled in sports events of state and national levels. We have been successful in organizing two Inter University Table-Tennis Tournaments—3 Day East Zone Inter University Table-Tennis (Women) Tournament and 3 Day East Zone Inter University Table Tennis (Men) Tournament with more than thirty teams participating from the entire eastern zone. It is a matter of pride that the University attained an NSS Grant amounting to INR 149,400 from the Office of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of India.

The University has expanded its collaborative enterprises such as eminent national as well as international educational institutes through MoU's. As on date we have more than 86 MoU's signed for the teaching, research collaboration, student and faculty exchange. In the last year, we joined hands with as many as 29 colleges of Assam, 16 polytechnic institutes, and 12 other national institutes of repute including the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). We also have signed an MoU with the Sun Moon University of South Korea, thereby furthering the way for international academic collaboration. This year Royal Global University has entered into an MoU with O.P Jindal Global University, under the Institutional Mentorship Agreement to help in curriculum, course outline, global competitive multidisciplinary programs and strengthening and streamlining of academic and administrative setup.

It is always rewarding when others recognize and appreciate the remarkable work and achievements of our university and its people. It gives me immense pleasure to share that our university has attained 150th rank by the Indian Institute of Ranking Framework (IIRF). We have a robust feedback system owing to which we have been monitoring our quality and continuously striving for progress.

About the Convocation

The Assam Royal Global University is organizing its third convocation on the 30th of October 2023. This convocation, for the graduating class of 2023, is an opportunity to celebrate the academic and co-curricular achievements of the students who have completed diploma, undergraduate and postgraduate programmes at the university. It marks the culmination of the students' academic, residential, emotional, and cultural journey.

In Today's Convocation, the University shall award degrees and diplomas to 1,197 Graduands, along with 42 gold, 45 silver, 02 Chancellor's Gold medals, four Salvors to students for their outstanding academic and co-curricular achievements. This year university is also conferring first eight Ph.D degrees in this convocation

For the First Convocation, the theme reflected the culture of Assam, Second Convocation reflected on the traditions and diverse culture of Meghalaya and this year the theme for the Third Convocation is based on the culture of the state of Manipur. This has been showcased throughout the campus through decorations depicting the state of Manipur. The Assam Royal Global University is proud of its diverse background of students mainly belonging to all the North Eastern States as well as other states of the country. In the coming years, the theme for the Convocation will be based on other states of North East India.

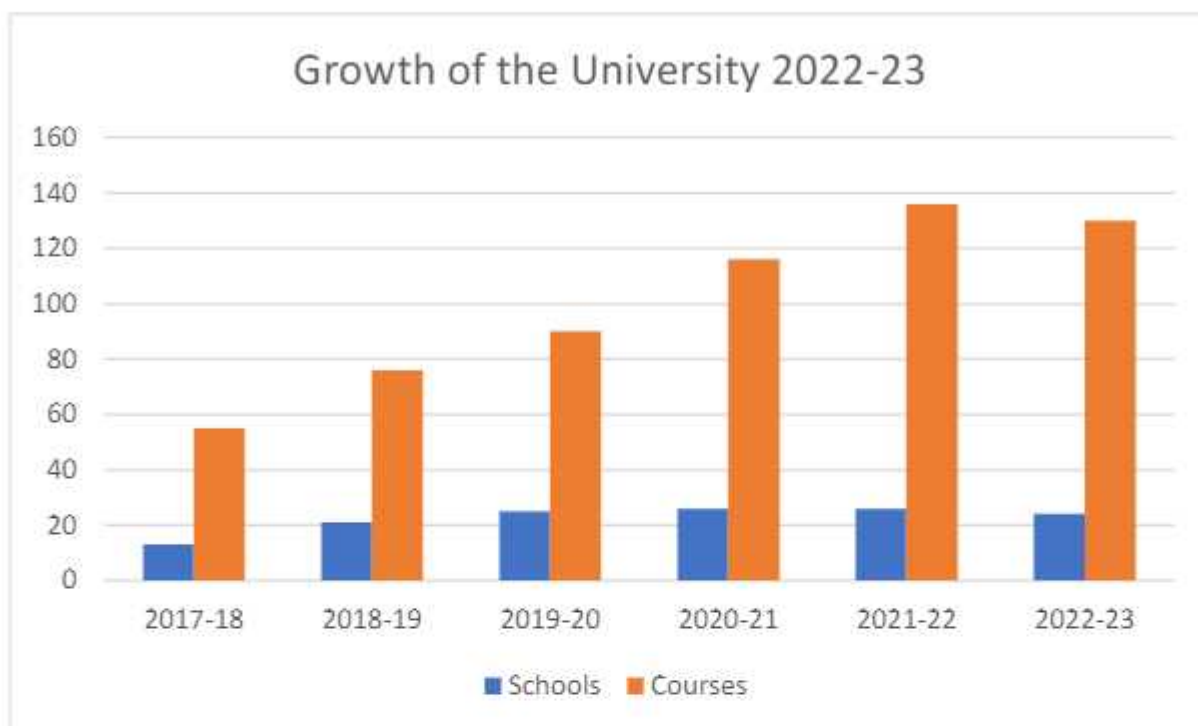
1. The University

The Assam Royal Global University is a state-private university, established by The Assam Royal Global University Act 2013, notified by the Government of Assam gazette notification on 23rd August 2013. Starting its first academic session in July 2017, The Assam Royal Global University is now offering 136 programmes and courses under its 24 schools. The university has seen remarkable growth in the last few years. As on date, we have 6500 students, 344 faculty members, 2000 plus publications & research engagements, 800 plus recruiters and 7000 plus alumni of RGI and RGU spread across the world. The University also has its presence across 7 states of the Northeast through its 19 Admission Information Centres to provide counselling and admission guidance to students of different states.

1.1 Growth of the University (2022-2023)

It is encouraging to witness the growth of the university with respect to the number of schools and courses from the time the university has come into existence. The university is experiencing an upward trend in student intake every year. Our journey started with a total of 792 admissions in various undergraduate, postgraduate, diploma, and Ph.D. programs in 2017-18. For the reporting year 2022-2023 the total admission stood at 2489 which included 1531 undergraduates, 790 postgraduates, 84 diploma, 17 in Integrated courses and 67 Ph.D scholars.

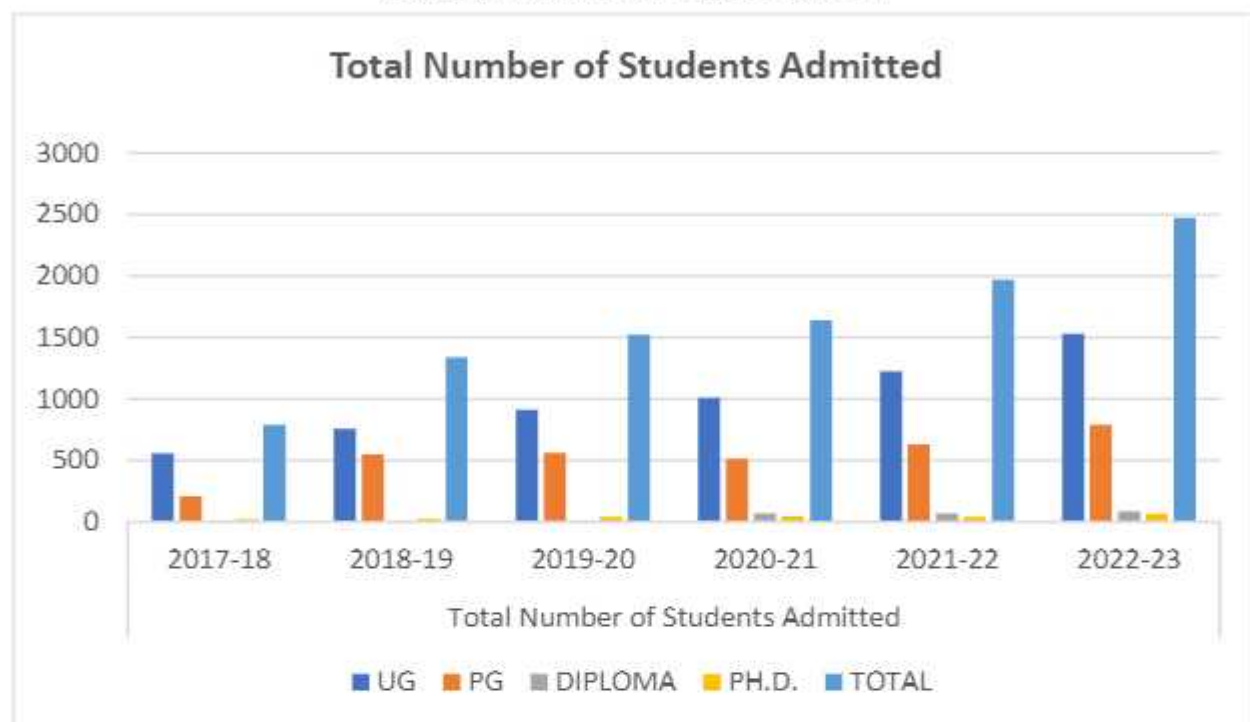


1.2 Student Strength

The Assam Royal Global University has become the most preferred destination for higher education for students from the region as well as other neighbouring states of the Northeast. The university is experiencing an upward trend in student intake every year. Our journey started in 2017-18 with a total of 792 admissions in various undergraduate, post-graduate, diploma, and Ph.D. courses across the university. This number grew to 1340 admissions in the year 2018-19, 1521 admissions in 2019-20 & 1641 admissions in 2020-21. In the academic year 2022-23, a total of 2472 students took admissions. Currently, the University has a total of 6500 plus students.

1.3 Student Scholarships

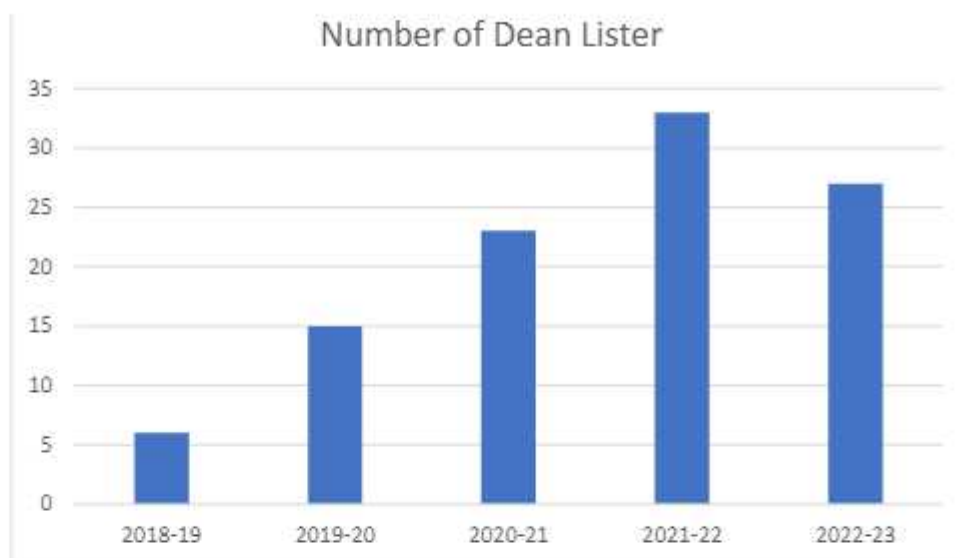
For social inclusion of all strata of the society, the university has a policy to support brilliant students by offering various scholarships. In the AY 2021-2022, a total of 59 scholarships under two broad categories, The Royal Merit Scholarship and The Royal Endowment Scholarship was awarded. This includes 100% scholarship to 1 students from the Chakma Community. The university also provides monthly scholarships of Rs.3000/- per month to semester toppers and a total of 94 scholarships have been awarded under this category during the reporting period.

1.5 Infrastructural Facilities

The Assam Royal Global University campus spans across 33 acres of land with about 12 lakh square feet built up centrally air-conditioned area available for running various courses in 9 academic blocks. It is facilitated with amphitheatre style classrooms centrally air-conditioned with Wi-Fi facilities, central library, hostels for both boys and girls, seminar halls, Colloquium, infirmary, playground, cafeteria, visitors lounge, Conference room, Board room, Common room, Studios, a Fashion Boutique, Computer center and 85+ high tech labs like physics, chemistry, pharmacy, nursing lab, Radiography, MLT, Food Technology, Optometry, Physiotherapy and several quality eating outlets.

The RGU Library boasts an impressive 8,000 square feet of modern, high-tech space. This centrally air-conditioned, well-furnished duplex library serves as an integrated resource center, housing an extensive collection of cutting-edge books

The Assam Royal Global University provides its hostel boarders with all the comforts one's home. The university has 4 separate in-campus hostels with 1000 beds in Aditya House, NE House (Boy's Hostels) and Harsha House, Samaya House (Girl's Hostels) are equipped with adequate facilities for holistic mental and physical growth of students.

2. University Awards and Accolades

Apart from awards & recognitions received in earlier years, the University has been awarded the following in 2022-23:

- The Assam Royal Global University has been ranked 150th among all Indian universities by the Indian Institutional Ranking Framework (IIRF) in May 2023.

3. Academic Activities

3.1 Academic Programmes

The university offers a variety of programmes and courses where the students can choose their course of study from traditional courses like Basic Science, and Humanities to technical courses like Engineering, Architecture, Pharmacy, etc., to modern and design courses like Communication Design, Product Design, Fashion Design, Fine Arts, etc. Having such inter-departmental studies at campus helps in implementing the true ethos of the 'Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) where a student pursuing UG in Science/Engineering/Arts may choose a generic elective in Fashion Design/ Fine Arts/Photography/Dance/Music/Sports. This further helps in promoting inter-disciplinary research as well.

The University offers UG, PG, Diploma and PhD courses in Engineering, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Architecture, Psychology, Bio-Sciences, Business Administration, Commerce, Mass Communication, Fashion Design, Communication Design, Environmental and Earth Sciences, Fine Arts, Hotel Management, Travel and Tourism, Humanities like Sociology, Social Work, History, Political Science, Information Technology, English, Law, Life Sciences, MLT, Nursing and Pharmacy.

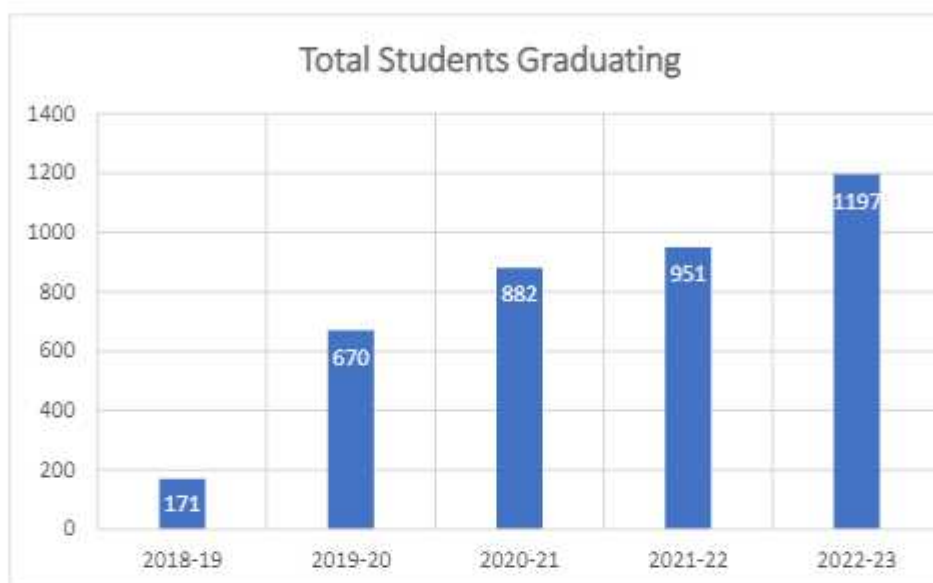
Two mandatory courses have been introduced in the curriculum for all the students of the university namely Communicative English and Behavioural Science to develop good communication skills and to enhance their overall personality. Further, The Assam Royal Global University also offers a program B. Com (H)- Finance and Accounts in collaboration with M/S ICA Edu Skills Pvt. Ltd., where students get exposure to a specifically customized curriculum with extensive internship opportunities in the third year.

3.2 Process Automation

The Assam Royal Global University has designed its own student management system called Royal Net to track, maintain and manage all the data generated by the departments. With the help of this specialised IT infrastructure, faculty members can upload student attendance, assignments, course materials, syllabus, lesson plans, etc. The students and parents can also view the attendance; download course materials, syllabus, etc. by using their credentials through Royal Net.

3.3 Number of Graduating Students

A total of 171 students had graduated in the year 2019, 670 in 2020, and 882 students in 2021. A total of 1723 were conferred their degrees in the First Convocation held on 30th March, 2022. In the Second Convocation a total of 951 students and in the Third Convocation 1197 graduands will be conferred their degrees.



3.4 Industry-Academia Interaction

To make the course curriculum industry-oriented, the university regularly organizes guest lectures and interactive sessions with industrialists and corporate officials. External members from the industry are also integral members of the Board of Studies (BOS) and the academic council of the university who advise the board on incorporating industry-relevant topics to bridge the industry-academia gap. Students from the University are sent for industrial visits regularly.

4. Teaching Pedagogy

The University presents a set of innovative pedagogical approaches that have the potential to guide teaching and transform learning.

1. This includes tutorial classes for slow and fast learners,
2. MOOCs and SWAYAM with a provision for earning extra credit,
3. Coaching for national level competitive exams like Civil Services/ GATE, NET/SLET etc. ,
4. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with Learning Outcome Curriculum Framework (LOCF) syllabus;
5. Compulsory course in Communicative English, Behavioural Science and many other subjects are offered from the basket of courses.
6. Motivating students for research publications, developing their research aptitude & research publication skills
7. Interactive sessions by experts from industry & academia
8. Use of ICT tools
9. Regular mock PI and GD sessions
10. Mandatory appearance in National level exams for students opting for placements
11. Compulsory library period to inculcate the habit of reading.

The Assam Royal Global University is actively engaged in research. The university, in the academic year 2022-2023, have published 147 research papers, 50 book chapters, submitted 38 projects out of which 5 already approved, amounting to Rs. 50 lakhs.

Numerous grants have been awarded to faculty members in 2022-2023 which include:

- NSS Grant amounting to Rupees One Lakh Forty-Nine Thousand and Four Hundred (Rs. 1,49,400) was released to the NSS-RGU Chapter from the Office of the Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Assam.
- A project grant from Northeastern Development Finance Corporation Limited (NEDFI Ltd.) amounting to Rupees three lakhs and fifty thousand (Rs. 3,50,000) to Mr. Moses Newme, Assistant Professor from the Department of Social Work.

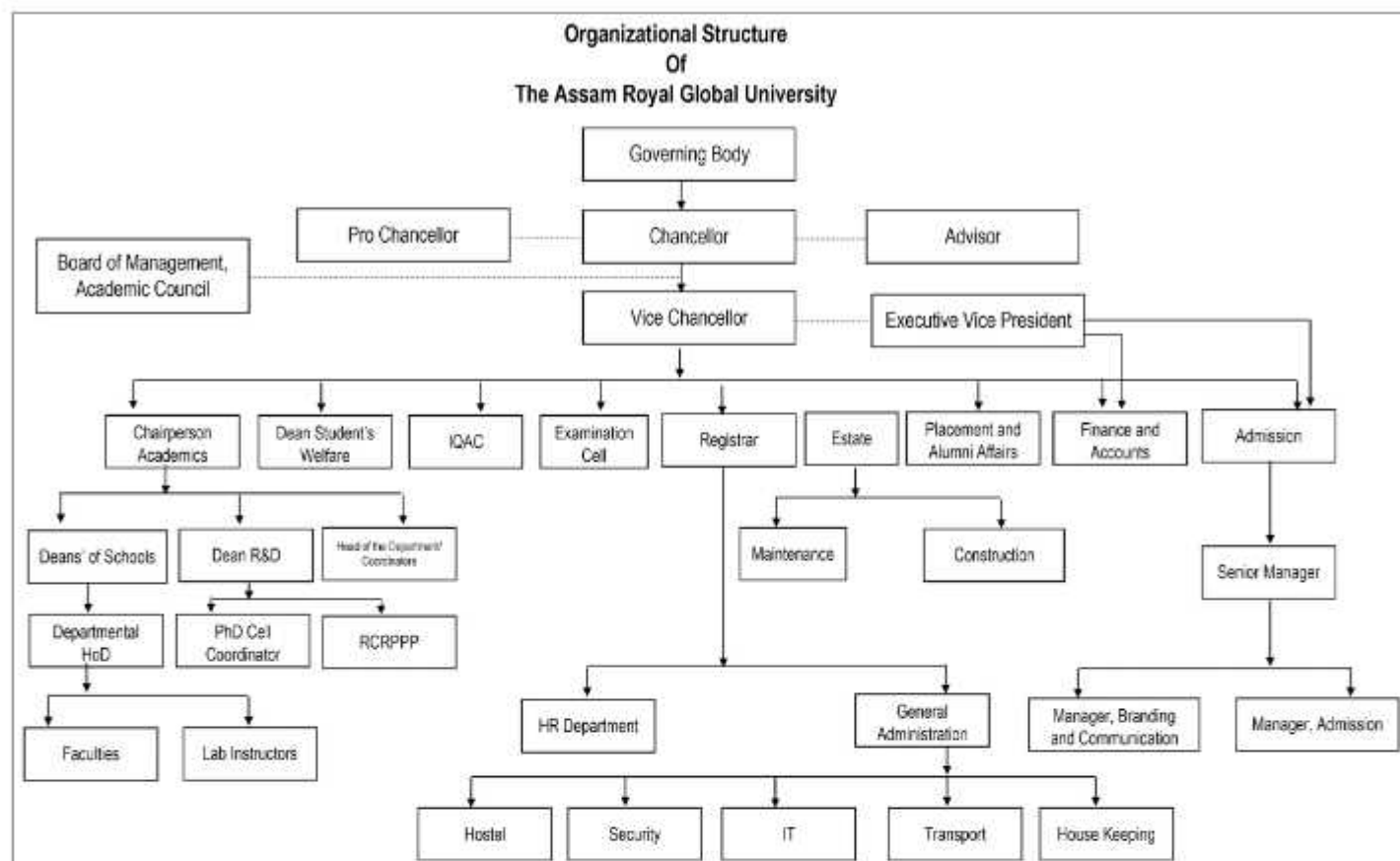
6. Student Achievements

8. Quality Enhancement Reforms (QER)

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was formed at The Assam Royal Global University in congruence with the guidelines laid down by the University Grants Commission in its first year in 2017 itself. Headed by late Prof. O.K. Medhi, Former Vice Chancellor Gauhati University, and Professor Emeritus, Royal School of Pure and Applied Sciences, and followed by Prof. (Dr.) A.K. Buragohain, Chairperson-Academic and Former Vice Chancellor, Dibrugarh University, it is currently led by Prof. (Dr.) Anuradha Devi, Dean, Royal School of Applied and Pure Sciences, and is working rigorously to achieve the next milestone of the university which is to get NAAC-A by the year 2023.

The IQAC also conducts regular academic, administrative, and energy audits to maintain the quality of all three domains. The last Academic and Administrative audit was done in the year 2022. The energy audit was conducted in 2023.

9. Curriculum Reforms

The university regularly updates the syllabi of programmes and courses through its Board of Studies constituted in every school as per the Act & Statutes of the University, meeting at least once or twice a year. Recommendations of the Board of Studies are further approved by the Academic Council. Both the Board of Studies and the Academic Council comprises one expert from the industry and one external member from academics to keep a balance with the requirement of both academics and industry.

10. Library

The Central Library at RGU spans an area of 743 square meters (equivalent to 8,000 square feet). This modern, well-furnished, centrally air-conditioned duplex library, located on the first and second floors of B block, serves as the academic nucleus for research and knowledge-seeking endeavors.

Our library is at the forefront of technology, fully computerized to provide essential information across a wide spectrum of disciplines, including engineering, management, architecture, law, commerce, fashion, fine arts, and more. Our impressive collection comprises 9,614 titles and 29,407 printed book volumes, as well as 13,042 e-books and access to 6,460 e-journals and e-articles. We offer diverse e-resources, including e-journals, e-books, and e-databases, accessible through our user-friendly Remote Access Software (Remotlog). And also provide an Online Public Access Catalogue (Web OPAC).

In addition to our vast collection, our library boasts special sections dedicated to the Northeast, competitive exam materials, and a fiction/non-fiction corner. We keep our users informed with subscriptions to three daily newspapers and a selection of renowned magazines.

To enhance the efficiency of library operations, we employ ILMs SOUL 3.0 server platform and a barcode system. We are proud members of DELNET, Manupatra, and JSTOR, which allow us to access resources from other institutions, enriching the knowledge landscape for our users. Similarly, the university also subscribes to MANUPATRA the legal e-Data base which national and international judgements and journals can be accessed.

11. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)

11.1 Communicative English and Behavioural Sciences

To enhance learners' communication skills by giving adequate exposure to English abilities, the University offers a compulsory course in Communicative English, taught in the six semesters in Undergraduate and all four semesters in Postgraduate programs. Another compulsory course is Behavioural Science, offered to students as it explores the cognitive processes, especially decision making and problem solving, through systematic analysis of human behaviour. These two courses are intended to support our students to be ready for the ever changing business environment and to perform better at both National and International levels.

11.2 Remedial Classes

Remedial classes for both Undergraduate and Post-Graduate students are organized regularly to create a strong foundation of the respective subjects which will help them prepare for future competitive examinations and pursue higher studies. In the remedial classes, concept clarification through NCERT books of classes 8 to 12 is taken up. Remedial/Tutorial classes for the backlog papers are also organized as per the convenience of the students on either

offline or online mode. Mentors are a part of the classes to ensure the smooth and proper functioning of classes and to make sure that the students understand the subjects thoroughly. The course-wise list of backlog student/s along with the classes held are maintained in the department.

12. Quality Enhancement Programme

The university organizes different programmes to strengthen the academic and research competency of the faculty members.

- **Faculty Colloquium (Faculty Seminar Series)**

- » **Faculty Colloquium (July-Sep 2022):** It was the seventh consecutive seminar of its kind, conducted by HRDC, RGU. This was organized from 18 July, 2022 to 14 Sep., 2022. The presenters were faculty members from all departments/schools of RGU. The sessions were held on every working day (Monday-Friday & working Saturday) from 4:00 PM to 5:15 PM (offline mode). Considering the growing number of faculty members in different departments, all the schools were allocated into five different groups and accordingly the sessions were conducted in different five venues (parallel sessions). In total, there was 18 (eighteen) days of deliberations.

- » **Faculty Colloquium (June-July 2023):** It was the eighth consecutive seminar of its kind, conducted by the HRDC, RGU. It was organized from 30 June to 26 July, 2023. The Faculty Colloquium started with an inaugural session on 30 June 2023, followed by presentations. The sessions were conducted in different five venues (parallel sessions). The sessions were held on every working day from 4:00 PM to 5:15 PM. This seminar encourages faculty members of the university to present their domain expertise on a common platform. Content of presentations included extensive range of topics, variety of inputs, and practical information from different schools of RGU. Most of the presenters presented their original works while some of them presented review works. On an average, there were 17 presentations per day.

- » **The Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC), RGU** engages a formal process for evaluating Faculty presentations. Judges nominated for the Annual Research-Work Presentation at RGU include esteemed Professors (Internal). The committee uses evaluation forms developed with criteria that best reviews originality, knowledge, content and overall presentation.

- » Faculty Colloquium showcases the commitment of our University to motivate research culture among various disciplines. This seminar also helps in bridging the gap between academia and industries for overall societal development.

13. Ph.D.

The quest for knowledge is the basic principle behind research. And therefore, The Assam Royal Global University urges its faculty members, research scholars and students towards good quality research. The quality of research work directly translates to the quality of teaching and learning in the classroom, thereby benefiting the students, the society, and the country. RGU promotes interdisciplinary research so that the scholars can collaborate with guides from different departments and can contribute towards some new innovative work which can help the society. A total of 66 research scholars are pursuing their Ph.D. degrees in this session which marks the total count of Ph.D. scholars at 192.

Ph.D. programmes are regularly monitored by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) and the Student Research Committee (SRC) on their research progress.

Every scholar is guided by a supervisor from The Assam Royal Global University and mandatorily co-guided by eminent academicians from other institutions of repute such as Tezpur Central University; University of Tartu, Estonia, and Delhi University, to name a few. There is also a provision of research fellowship for meritorious Ph.D. candidates where they are provided a monthly fellowship.

The University encourages interdisciplinary research to broaden the research acumen of its scholars. Few of the thrust areas include anthropological heritage and history of the North-eastern region of India, language and literature, design thinking, artificial intelligence and machine learning, bioinformatics, etc.

14. Training and Placement

The Training and placement department of Royal Global University is named as the Royal Centre for Corporate Relations (RCCR) which is an indispensable pillar of the University and plays a very important role in every student's future. The centre continuously strives to help students in pursuing their career goals by imparting employment-seeking skills and thereby to attain desired employment. This is accomplished through a strong bondage created amongst students, alumni, faculty members and industry.

The Royal Centre for Corporate Relations attempts towards mentoring students to the effect that they are industry-ready at the successful completion of an academic programme. The centre parallelly aims at grooming students ethically as well as in terms of attitude and aptitude, through regular training and interactive sessions. The centre provides students with every support for placements. The main objective of this Centre is to make the students ready to face the challenges of the corporate world and to help them in getting placed after completing a course.

The alumni network of the University is growing every year with more than 6000 alumni of RGI and RGU. The alumni network has a 3 fold objective that includes creating a strong network of alumni, mentoring, and supporting the current students in training, placements, incubation, etc. The idea behind this is to create an alumni fund as endorsement which will create more opportunities for the students.

Over the years, many students have qualified for the GATE, JAM, NET, TET examinations. Mr. Manab Kalita, Dept. of Chemistry (2017-19) and Mr. Mahamanikya Brahma, M.Sc. Botany (2018-2020) cleared CSIR NET JRF with All India ranks 88 and 266 respectively. In addition to this, 9 students cleared GATE, 3 cleared JAM and many more students cleared SLET, CTET, IBPS, CAT and other significant examinations this year.

Our alumni are pursuing higher studies in many prestigious foreign universities like Cardiff University, University of Toronto, University of South Florida, and The New York Institute of Technology, to name a few. Ms. Chitrani Goswami from the Royal School of Fine Arts has been selected for Scholarship and a seat at Fine Art Academy in NABA Milan, Italy.

15. Royal Centre for Act East Policy Studies

The 'Act East Policy', as enunciated by the Government of India, has made a deep impression in the minds and hearts of every Indian. With the objective of creating an awareness for Research and Studies amongst its faculty and students, the Royal Centre for Act East Policy has been set up in the year 2018.

The Centre seeks to achieve its objectives through workshops, seminars, lectures, research collaborations and cultural events as well as publications and extensive dissemination.

- The research focus will include migration and trans-nationalism, economic benefits of bilateral and multilateral trade, gender discrimination, conflict and livelihood issues, ethnicity and identity politics, water, environment and climate change, North East India and its peripheral areas, traditional institutions and India's Look East Policy Research and several academic studies in the Centre.

Those competitions inspired the children to come out of the world of technology and the real game. It will increase their reasoning power, visual perception skills cognitive thinking and strategy skills. The Primary goal of this club is to teach basic understanding of the rules of chess for beginning players as well as critical analysis of the tactics of the game for more advanced players.
- **Confluence** – Confluence, the cultural club of Royal Global University, the word confluence itself means coming together or joining together as so it serves as an essential hub for nurturing and celebrating diverse cultural expressions. It recognizes the profound importance of music, dance, art, and other artistic expressions in a university setting. By embracing and promoting music, dance, art, and various art forms, Confluence enriches the university experience, providing students with opportunities to explore their talents, develop their artistic abilities, and foster a sense of identity and belonging. These creative outlets also serve as platforms for cross-cultural exchange, encouraging dialogue, appreciation, and respect for diverse perspectives. The presence of such artistic endeavors in the university community nurtures a vibrant and inclusive environment that celebrates the beauty and power of human creativity.
- **Cricket Club** - Cricket is a most famous and passionate sports of India for many years. It is one of the favourites and well-played game. Cricket Club of The Assam Royal Global University organises cricket tournaments every year. This club offers proper ground with all rules and norms. It aims to provide, maintain and grow opportunities for students and all members to play quality cricket in a friendly and positive environment in the true spirit of the game. The club also provide basic household necessities to low- income individuals and families at no cost.
- **Media Club** – The Media Club of Royal Global University has played a crucial role in the university and its events, serving as an integral part of enhancing the academic and artistic aspects of the students on campus. Whenever the university and its students organize an event, the media club takes the lead in ensuring that it is captured on camera and promoted through its dedicated platform, 'Royal Times'. This initiative has provided a remarkable platform for students with a keen interest in cinematography, photography, and various other aspects of media. The media club has been proactive in training a considerable number of students in areas such as PR writing, editing, videography, photography, and equipment handling. Through two weekly sessions, the club imparts valuable skills to individuals interested in these fields. - **Sansad Club** - The Sansad Club is one of the youngest Clubs of the University formally established in April 2023. Derived from the Sanskrit word, 'samsad' which means assembly and discussion, we aim at creating a discussion and learning platform for all the politically conscious students and harness their energies and channelize a pool of conscientious and responsible citizens. Our vision is to cultivate a stream of politically conscious students who possess the ability to think critically and initiate transformative change within society. We aspire to be a platform that nurtures politically aware youth, serving as a beacon for change makers, visionaries, and leaders who are determined to shape their own lives and revolutionize the world around them. Our club is dedicated to empowering individuals with the knowledge, awareness, and skills necessary to become agents of positive change. We strive to foster a community that encourages open dialogue, where members can freely voice their opinions, engage in meaningful discussions, and collaboratively make informed decisions.

18. Events

The Assam Royal Global University inculcates the value of self-introspection and involving student to learn by doing. In this process of orientation towards learning, university focusses upon conducting co-curricular, extra-curricular academic outreach-inbound and outbound activities for the holistic development of the students. University across, school/department-wise activities are organized and conducted by the faculties and students. The onus of learning is on the students coordinated by faculties. Important events including seminar, conferences, workshop, training programs, extension activities, student-driven fests, student-workshops for hands-on experience, visit to industries and allied institutions.

The important events conducted by the university are:

- Total number of seminars organized: 88
- Total number of workshops: 41
- Total number of industrial visits: 37
- Total number of training programs: 12 (including faculty and students)
- Total number of events in different schools: 213

Various landmark events of the university in the Academic Year 2022-2023 include the biggest Job Fair of the Northeast Region to be organized by an academic institution. The Job Fair had 125+ reputed organizations like Wipro, Tech Variable, Star Cements, Novotel Guwahati, etc. that offered more than 800 jobs to the applicants. It is noteworthy to mention that a total of over 3000 plus candidates registered for this mega-event.

The university's Royal Centre for Corporate Relations also held an HR Conclave that saw participation from fraternity members from Wipro, Cognizant, Schneider Electric India, Fortum India, Knorr Bremse, Aditya Birla Group and others, thereby emerging as the most sought-after event lined up in the academic fraternity of the region.

University has a registered Alumni Association with 7000+ students with an objective to create wide network and endowment fund for university. In future, we are going to have Alumni Chapters in the major cities of the country. The university has signed a total of 85 MoUs with leading institutions of India and abroad. This includes technical colleges and polytechnics for an opportunity of student-faculty exchange and joined collaboration for teaching and research.

Technophilia

June 29th, 2022 saw the resuming of Technophilia inaugurated by the Chairman of the Technical Board of IT Guwahati, Prof. (Dr.) Chivakulu Devraj Sastri. The Computer Science department of Gauhati University also released the departmental magazine "Projukti" during the inauguration ceremony. The two-day festival was enriched with an incredible TechTalk event presented by Prof. Shyamanta Moni Hazarika, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering, IIT, Guwahati along with the RGU Chairperson for Academics, Prof. Alak Kumar Buragohain, and Prof. (Dr.) Aniruddha Deka, Head of Departments in RSIT and RSET (CSE). With more participants from around the city and state, many events like Valorant Gaming, extravagant Cosplay, Brainiac, Innovanza, Coding competition were conducted successfully. After a long day of events, the second day of Technophilia 2022 came to an end with an amazing closing ceremony full of performances by the RGU Students Cultural Club.

19. University Social Responsibility

The University acknowledges its social responsibility and has adopted various schemes and initiatives. We believe that the few initiatives of our Hon'ble Chancellor will create a positive impact on our students, society and make a substantial difference in people's lives.

These initiatives are:

- a. Royal Anna Seva wherein wholesome meal is distributed to 101 underprivileged people every day.
- b. Royal Swasthya Seva, a clinic with a qualified doctor and nurse is available in the University for free consultation and free medicine of regular nature to the people of the neighbouring locality, for the students and staff of the university.
- c. Royal Vaastra Seva is a cloth donation initiative by the university which aims to collect clothes from students and staff of the university for all age groups, on the university campus. These clothes are further distributed to the people in need.

Students of the University are regularly taking teaching sessions at the Tetelia L.P. School, which the University had adopted. The University provides for subsidized facilities for X-Ray, diagnostics, physiotherapy and radiology services for the benefit of the local community.

Several other initiatives like blood donation camps, flood relief, etc. were also undertaken by the university. Additionally, the University contributes to a healthy environment by producing Vermicompost and Biogas for use in the University as well as for the staff and faculty members. Clean and Green Campus is our motto and we have a sewage treatment plant, solar power generation and an efficient solid waste disposal system. Further, the university campus is plastic and tobacco free.

19.1 Royal Legal Clinic

The University, in collaboration with The Royal School of Law and Administration, has established the Royal Legal Clinic in the university premises in the year 2023. The objective of this clinic is to provide free legal services and consultations for free to the members of the university and individuals who may in need for legal services.

19.2 Extending Knowledge Beyond RGU

The Assam Royal Global University is assisting Tetelia L.P. School, Dimoria, Kamrup(M) for imparting classes in Science, Maths, English, Fine Arts, etc.

19.3 Other Activities

Various departments of the university have taken up activities for social cause such as blood donation, counselling cell, physiotherapy OPD, legal aid cell, vermicomposting etc.

20. National Service Scheme (NSS) Cell

The Assam Royal Global University has been granted two units of National Service Scheme (NSS), comprising of 50 volunteers each, set up by the Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of Assam. The Cell has conducted a series of events specifically aimed at the skill-development for Anganwadi workers, school teachers, and enhancement of employability for the youth of Assam.

21. Environment Friendly Campus

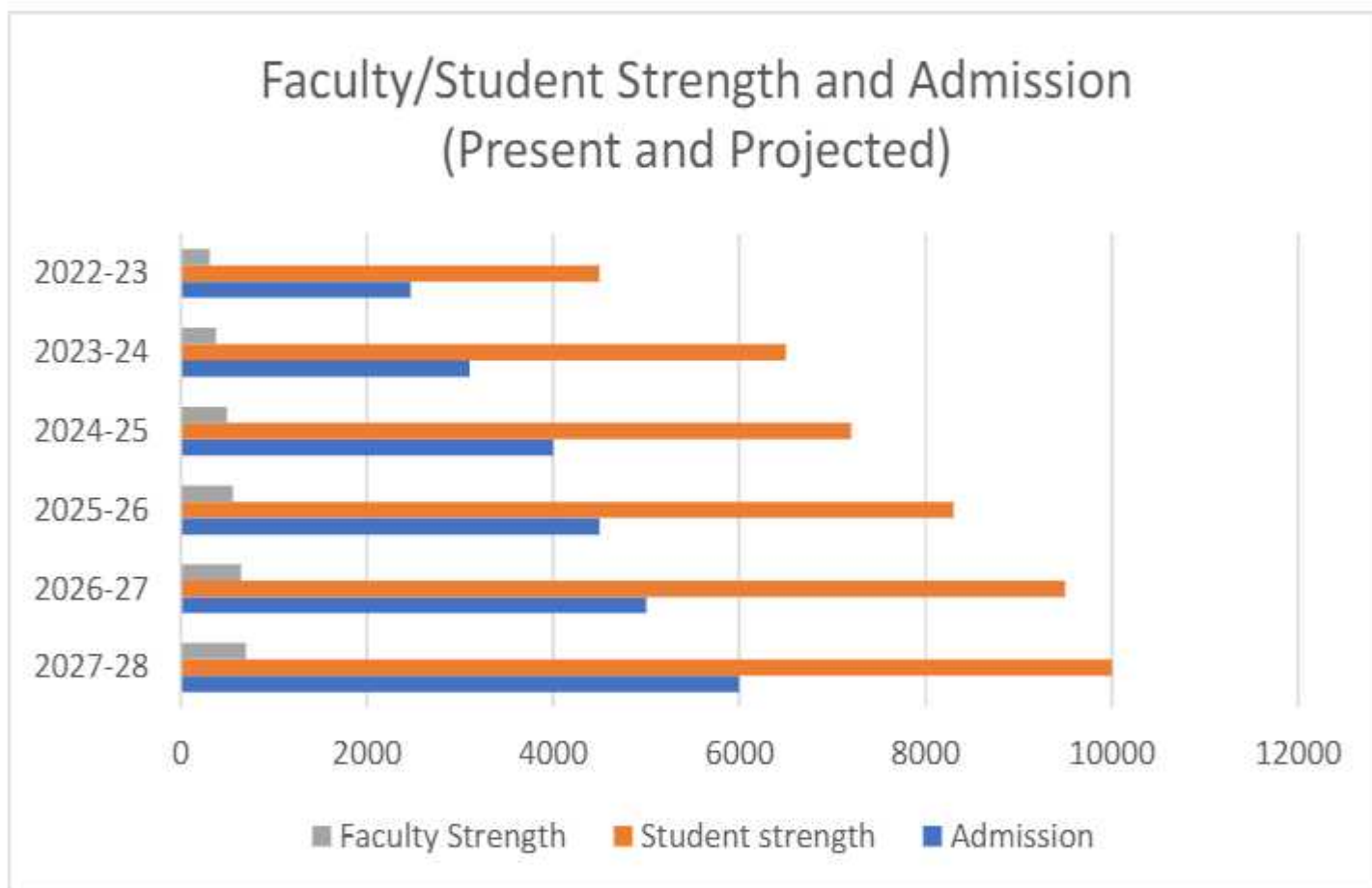
Solar panels (of 330 kws) are set up in the campus, producing about 30000-35000 units of electricity per month. The extra electricity generated after the day-to-day consumption is pooled by the Green Grid. The university is working towards a green campus and has rainwater harvesting, vermi-composting, tree plantation etc. in place. Proper segregation and disposal process for solid waste is also done regularly. The students are being motivated to participate in frequent tree plantation drives. The Government of Assam has also given the project of planting trees/beautification and maintenance of ISBT flyover, Garchuk to the University. The University had pledged NO to single use plastic and for a No Tobacco Zone and was awarded a certificate jointly by District Tobacco Control Cell and Joint Commissioner Health, Kamrup in this regard.

- Activation of Royal Centre for inter-disciplinary teaching and research
- Auditorium of 3000 capacity along with resource centre of 60,000 sq. ft.
