Minutes of Board of Studies Meeting

# Royal School of Commerce

The Assam Royal Global University Guwahati – 35 The 1<sup>st</sup> Board of Studies meeting of Royal School of Commerce was held on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 at the Conference Room, Royal Global University at 12:45 P. M. The following points were discussed in the meeting:

- 1. It was advised to incorporate SWAYAM (online) courses as provided by UGC in lieu of some of the Core Papers only viz., Principles of Management among others. Such courses should not be made an option for Discipline Specific Courses.
- 2. The paper Indian Economics was suggested to be renamed as Business Environment as it would be more of an analytical based subject under Commerce.
- 3. In the paper Financial Accounting, the Unit on Self-Balancing Ledger was opined to be replaced with Computerised Accounting System.
- 4. It was stressed to be taken into consideration those similar papers or units belonging to both UG and PG level should not have overlapping topics. In this regard, one of the units in the paper Business Organisation named Business Ethics was suggested to be replaced with some other relevant topic as the same would be covered by the paper on Auditing & Corporate Governance.
- 5. As far as the Discipline Specific Courses are concerned, it was asked to furnish with more options of subjects if possible.
- **6.** The paper Rural Finance at UG level was asked to be renamed as Micro Finance and Rural Development.
- 7. The Unit Portfolio Revision was suggested to be renamed as Portfolio Evaluation while the former should be included as a topic in the unit with regard to the paper Securities Analysis and Portfolio Management at the PG level.
- 8. The paper Advanced Accounting should be replenished with a Chapter on Insolvency of other business forms in concurrence with the latest legislation in this regard.
- 9. Advanced Taxation, a paper at the PG level was found to have similar contents with the UG level Indirect Taxes and Income Tax Law and Practice paper; as such the content was asked to be revised. It was also suggested that since this paper would be somewhat of a repetition of the UG level, so it was advised to change the paper into Working Capital Management or Tax Planning. In this context, the paper on Working Capital Management could comprise of Units on Introduction, Receivables Management, Cash Management and Inventory Management while the paper on Tax Planning would be served if experts could be hired for deliberations.

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- 10. With regard to the paper Advanced Cost and Management Accounting, the units were asked to be redrafted keeping the following points in mind:
  - a. Concepts of various types of costs and their application
  - b. Application of costing tools in management decision making
  - c. Various management accounting techniques
  - d. Tactical and Strategic Decision making
  - e. Behavioural Aspect of Budget

A Book for reference suggested was Management Control System - By Rishi/Anthony and Govinda Rajan.

- 11. The paper Corporate Reporting also called for some revisions viz., inclusion of Segment Reporting in unit III and positioning this unit after Unit IV. The unit on tools of analysis was advised to lay emphasis on Ratio Analysis with specific study on Liquidity, Profitability and Solvency. Further inclusion of inter-firm comparison was recommended.
- 12. The paper Business Statistics was discussed to include the topic Interpolation and exclude Probability completely. While a whole unit of Probability should be included as a unit at PG level.
- 13. Considering the paper Contemporary Issues in Accounting, Inflation Accounting is to be included as a Unit.
- 14. Travel & tourism was not observed to be a proper Skill Enhancement paper. The papers in Skill Enhancement Ability course to be enhanced with the following:
  - a. Cyber Laws
  - b. Event Management
  - c. E-filing of returns
  - d. Life skills and Stress Management etc.
- 15. Internship & Teaching Practice to be reconsidered and provided with options of papers.
- 16. The syllabus for Ph.D course work paper 3 (Recent Trends in Commerce) prepared in consultation with Prof. NB Dey and Prof. UR Dhar is duly approved by the BOS.

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## Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> BOS Meeting

**ROYAL SCHOOL OF COMMERCE** 

The **2**<sup>nd</sup> **Board of Studies** meeting of Royal School of Commerce was held on 29<sup>th</sup> of November, 2018 at Block C, Room No.101, Royal Global University at 3.30 p.m. The following points were discussed in the meeting –

- The RGU Examination Evaluation and Credit pattern to be circulated to all the departments of the University for easy reference.
- 2. It was suggested that the title names of Unit 2 and 3 of the subject Income Tax Laws and Practices are to be renamed as Tax on Salary Income (unit 2) and Tax on Other Income (unit 3) without making any changes in their respective contents.
- 3. It was advised to quote for the latest editions of the books in the reference sections of the syllabus content without mentioning the years. Also, recent changes are to be adopted with respect to the subjects of Law and Accounting and the same should be mentioned in the syllabus. Further, the term 'first editions' are to be replaced with the term 'latest editions' in the reference books and text books section of the syllabus for ease of the students.
- It was suggested to include the basics of data collection, table preparation and classification of data in the first unit of the paper Business Statistics.
- 5. It was further proposed that unit 2 of the paper Corporate Accounting should include the concept of ESOP and Sweat Shares in brief. Also, the topic of Company Annual Reports is to be added in the subject Advanced Accounting.

- It was suggested to include the topic Types of Financial Services in the paper of Financial Services.
- 7. It was also suggested in the meeting that the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Skill Based Papers of B.Com. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semester should be project based (with reduced credit period) and may include visit to industries, online trading in classroom and visits by experts which is to be exhibited in the syllabus.

It was also proposed that the subject of E-Commerce is to be considered as a skill based paper and may include two papers in the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters respectively. The first paper to be considered as a theoretical paper in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester and the second paper as a practical paper in the 6<sup>th</sup> semester.

- It was also stressed in the meeting to include the cost concepts of managerial decision making process, decision making factors and pay-back period in the paper of Management Accounting.
- Also the paper of Advertising and Sales promotion can be project based (to be prepared by the students) for internal evaluation and mentioned in the syllabus.
- 10. The topic of task control is to be added in the last part of Unit 1 in the paper of Advanced Cost and Management. Also, it was suggested that the new edition of the text book by Govind Rajan should be referred for the same.
- 11. It was also suggested that practical preparation of a project has to be made compulsory for internal assessment in the paper of Project Management.

Further as per the discussions, topic on franchising in the Paper of Retail Management and topic of Working Capital Liquidity Analysis and National Income Accounting is to be added in the paper of Financial Analysis.

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## Minutes of the 3rd BOS Meeting

### ROYAL SCHOOL OF COMMERCE

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Board of Studies meeting of Royal School of Commerce was held on 13<sup>th</sup> of May, 2019 at Block C, Room no.101, Royal Global University at 3.15 p.m. The following points were discussed in the meeting –

- The topic related to Computer based Auditing to be added in unit 2 of 'Auditing and Corporate Governance' subject of B.Com.5<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- It was suggested that the topic relationship between capital structure and financial structure should be added in unit 2 of Financial Management subject of B.Com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- Also the subject of Banking Law and Practice should include the RBI guidelines regarding NPA and the topic on need of stress management to be added in the subject Organizational Behaviour.
- 4. It was further proposed in the meeting to specify the meaning, contents and disclosure of company annual reports and also to include comparative advantages and disadvantages of CFA and FFA in the subject of Financial Statement Analysis.
- It was also recommended to include the concept of Consolidated Fund, Public Accounts and Contingency Fund under the topic of classification of accounts in Unit 4 of Advanced Accounting.
- 6. It was further proposed to include the topic advertising budget in the subject Advertising Management.
- 7. A complete guideline to be prepared for project submission of B.Com.5<sup>th</sup> semester.
- 8. It was further proposed in the meeting that the subject Training and Development of M.Com.4<sup>th</sup> Semester to be replaced by the subject Compensation Management (due to repetition of few of its topics in HRD subject in M.Com.1<sup>st</sup> Semester). The complete syllabus of the same was presented in the meeting and was accepted by the Board.

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The **Special Board of Studies** meeting of Royal School of Commerce was held on 1<sup>st</sup> of October, 2019 at BOG, Royal Global University at 3.15 p.m. The following points were discussed in the meeting –

- The course structure and detailed syllabus of B.Com Course to be as per the UGC model syllabus so that it becomes at par with the syllabus of other top universities of the country.
- The syllabus should always incorporate the recent developments in the field of concerned fields in order to make aware the students with the latest changes taking place across the globe.
- 3. It is also suggested that the syllabus should facilitate in enhancing students' employ-ability.
- The complete syllabus of B.Com and M.Com was presented in the meeting and was accepted by the Board.

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### Minutes of meeting of Board of Studies of Royal School of Commerce held on 24th May 2020

- At the very beginning the concept of UGC syllabus was explained by Prof HC Gautam to all the members and stated that minimum deviation from UGC syllabus can be made while drafting the RGU syllabus (maximum 30% deviation can be made).
- 2. CA Pankaj Jain stated that he will let his points know regarding the syllabus, a day after by email to Dr. Sudip Chakraborty.
- 3. As per Prof HC Gautam Syllabus which has been redrafted is ok from his point.
- 4. LTPC for Financial Accounting 1 credit to be assigned for Practical as it has practical based application (1 credit for practical i.e 2hours)
- 5. For Core paper 1 tutorial must be there as suggested by Chairperson Academics as conveyed Dr. Monalisa Bora.
- 6. Dr. Sudip Chakraborty further added that 1 tutorial class is there for all core papers and it is already been followed at RSC.
- 7. Tutorial may be included as non credit as suggested by Dr. Monalisa Bora.
- 8. Evaluation pattern to be looked into with certain changes in the distribution of the marks which is to be spoken to the Examination Department by Dr. Sudip Chakraborty. (suggested by Prof HC Gautam)
- 9. Number of text books to be increased to 2 which was previously kept as 1.
- 10. Recent edition of books to be referred, (along with it a note to be put in the syllabus that recent edition to be followed)
- 11. CA Pankaj Jain suggested to put some subject regarding Digital marketing.
- 12. E-Commerce & Digital Marketing to be included in replacement of Insurance and Risk Management or it can be put as option to it in GE.
- 13. Prof HC Gautam has requested CA Pankaj Jain to review the paper Consumer affairs and sovereignty.

#### MINUTES OF THE 5th BOS MEETING:

#### ROYAL SCHOOL OF COMMERCE

Deputy Dean i/c Royal School of Commerce welcomes the external experts, nominees of Honorable office of the Registrar and faculties from Royal School of Commerce.

The minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> BOS Meeting of Royal School of Commerce which was held on 17<sup>th</sup> of July,2021 through online Mode (Zoom Platform) are as follows -

1. At the very outset Deputy Dean i/c Royal School of Commerce explained the course structure for suggestion and approval of the subject experts.

- 2. It was also suggested that the subject Human Resource Management in B.Com. 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester to be transferred forward to B.Com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester in place of Financial Services so that the credit score lessens in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester benefitting the students. Hence, there may be only 2 core subjects in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester i.e. Management Principles and Income tax law and practice.
- 3. It was further suggested that the subject Financial Statement Analysis (FSA) to be introduced as DSE Paper in B.Com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester from a Core Paper in the existing course structure of B.Com.6<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- 4. The subject Business Incubation to be shifted to B.Com.4<sup>th</sup> Sem in place of HRPD.
- 5. Also, discussion was made on shifting the subject Financial Services to B.Com. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester from the existing B.Com.5<sup>th</sup> Semester (as replacement of FSA subject).
- The subject Auditing to be shifted to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester from existing 6<sup>th</sup> Semester and to be replaced with Principles of Marketing.
- It was also suggested that the scheme of evaluation for the subject Computer Applications in Business of B.Com. 4<sup>th</sup> Semester should be in the basis of 40% for Theory and 60% for Practical.
- 8. A discussion was also made on the implementation and feasibility of MOOC and SWAYAM Courses for the students of Royal School of Commerce in upcoming semesters for which the Guidelines of RGU shall be made into practice (as adviced by Mr. J. K. Bhattarcharjee, Nominee of Honorable Office of the Registrar). Also it is adviced to approach the meriterious students to register for atleast one paper in the SWAYAM platform for earning some extra credit which may be beneficial for them in terms of employability.(on experimental basis)
- 9. Further, Prof. HC Gautam suggested some minor modification in the syllabus of Financial Accounting.
- 10. It was also suggested that the scheme of evaluation for the subject Computer Fundamentals of B.Com. (F&A) 1<sup>st</sup> Semester should be Practical in place of theory keeping in mind the intent of the course.

11. There was no changes suggested in the course structure for M.Com. Course.

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### MINUTES OF 6th BOS MEETING OF ROYAL SCHOOL OF COMMERCE:

The 6<sup>th</sup> BOS Meeting of Royal School of Commerce, was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> of December,2021 in a blended mode from 6.30 p.m.

Some of the crucial modifications and suggestions made during the meeting for the current course structure of RSC are as follows -

#### I: B.COM. (H) Course:

- 1. No changes were suggested in B.Com.1st and 2nd semester course structure.
- 2. However, in B.Com. 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester the core paper of **Human Resource Management** has been removed and thereby the other two papers i.e. Management Principles and Applications and Income Tax Law and Practices remains unchanged.
- 3. It was also suggested to shift the core paper of Principles of Marketing from 6<sup>th</sup> Semester to 4<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- 4. Cost Accounting paper to be shifted from 4th Semester to 5th Semester.
- 5. The DSE paper of Advanced Financial Management to be shifted to 4<sup>th</sup> Semester from 6<sup>th</sup> Semester and the DSE paper of Management Accounting to be shifted from 4<sup>th</sup> semester to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- 6. The core paper of Auditing to be shifted from 5th Semester to 6th Semester.
- 7. In B.Com. 4<sup>th</sup> Semester, the DSE Paper of Human Resource Planning and Development has been replaced with the paper Brand Management (other papers remained unchanged)
- 8. In B.Com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester, the paper Financial Services has been replaced with the paper Human Resource Management.
- 9. In B.Com. 6th Semester, the paper Financial Statement Analysis has been replaced with Financial Services.

Further, the paper named Business Incubation has been removed from the course structure instead replaced with the Management paper of Human Resource Planning and Development in 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.

Note: The credit points of the subjects remained unchanged i.e, Core & DSE 5 credits, GE 3 credits

#### II: M.COM. Course:

- 1. In 1st Semester the paper named Insurance Management has been replaced with the paper Economic Legislations (Other subjects remains unchanged).
- 2. In 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester, the paper Legal Aspects of Business has been replaced with the paper named Marketing policy Analysis and Business Economics instead of Managerial Economics (other papers remains unchanged).
- 3. No changes have been suggested in 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester.
- 4. In 4<sup>th</sup> Semester, the paper named Sustainable Development has been introduced replacing the subject Micro-Finance. Further, Personal Finance has been replaced with International Business and Venture Creation replaced with the introduction of the Paper Entrepreneurship Development and Venture Creation in the course.

Note: The credit points of the subjects remained unchanged i.e, Core & DSE 4 credits

III: B.COM. (F&A) Course: The decision taken on the meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 with regard to the syllabus of B.Com (F&A) is approved by the board. (a copy attached)

Note: The credit points of the subjects remained unchanged i.e, core paper 5 credits, GE 3 credits

IV: It was further proposed by Dr. Sudip Chakraborty to add Apprenticeship Program for B.Com.6<sup>th</sup> Semester students of Day Shift on a mandatory basis and optional for B.Com. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester Morning Shift Students for Three Days a week or half-day for 5 days a week to add value to their B.Com. Course with practical applicability.

V: A suggestion was also put forward by Prof. H.C. Gautam to have compulsory Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) for 5 Marks (at least) in the final set of Question Papers for students of M.Com. in order to prepare them for appearing NET Exam and other competitive Examinations in near future.

#### Action Taken:

- 1. Accordingly necessary modification being incorporated in the syllabus for the approval of the Academic Council of the Royal Global University.
- 2. Necessary proposal for apprenticeship programme is sent to ICSI-NE Chapter and also to Guwahati Branch of EIRC of ICAI and the same is under review by both the institutes.

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## MINUTES OF 7th BOS MEETING OF ROYAL SCHOOL OF COMMERCE:

The 7<sup>th</sup>BOS Meeting of Royal School of Commerce, was held on 19<sup>th</sup> of May,2022 in an offline mode from 11 A.M.

Deputy Dean In-Charge, RSC welcomed the members of Board of Studies Royal School of Commerce and external member Prof A. P Singh to the the 7th BoS meeting of RSC

Prof A. P Singh has given a brief introduction regarding the implementation of NEP 2022, in Royal School of Commerce.He was further gave his consent regarding the core paper in the B.Com structure as these papers are as per UGC norms and the grouping of DSL papers from 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards as Accountancy, Management and Finance as specialized papers. Besides, he also enquired about implementation of MOOC courses within the course structure

Some of the crucial modifications and suggestions made during the meeting for the current course structure of B.COM.(H), RSC are as follows -

- (i) It was suggested that GE Papers Micro Economics and Macro Economics of B.Com. 1st and B.Com. 2nd Semester needs to be replaced with the paper Business Economics and Indian Economy. It was also recommended to simplify the syllabus for commerce students in consultation with the concerned faculties of the Economics Department of the University.
- (ii) In the paper Management Principles and Application taught in 3° semester, it has been advised to include case studies by emphasizing on the application aspects and further to include short cases in the End Semester Examination for the subject as well.
- (iii) In the DSE paper of Banking and Insurance in B Com 3rd Semester it has been advised to include the following topics in relevant units -
  - Role of banking in promoting entrepreneurship
  - Role of banking in cashless economy
  - Role of privatization of insurance sector
  - Growth of insurance in private sector
  - Private Versus Public Insurance companies
- (iv) Suggestions were made to reframe the AEEC Paper of Time Management in 4th Semester.
- (v) Further a proposal was given by Prof. II C Gautam in the meeting to introduce IPR (Intellectual Property Right) as an open elective paper for Skill Unhancement.

Prof. Singh also enquired regarding the implementation of NEP 2020. A thorough discussion is made regarding the same and ultimately it was advised to follow the guidelines of the University for implementation of NEP, 2020, to be applicable for B Com (F&A), as well from the academic year 2022-23.

The 9<sup>th</sup>BOS Meeting of Royal School of Commerce, was held on 6<sup>th</sup> of April,2023 in an offline mode from 3 P.M. The meeting was chaired by External Member Prof. Amrit Pal Singh, renowned academician, Department of Commerce, Gauhati University and renowned industrialist Mr. Manoj Bajaj so as to provide their valuable inputs in formulating the syllabi as per academic-industry requirement. Other members present in the meeting were –

- (i) Dr. Sudip Chakraborty, Deputy Dean In-Charge RSC
- (ii) Mr. Srawan Goenka, Coordinator RSC
- (iii) Moon Moon Ahmed, Nominee of Registrar, The Assam Royal Global University
- (iv) Dr. Aruna Dev Rroy, Associate Professor, RSC and Nominee of Vice Chancellor, The Assam Royal Global University
- (v) Dr. Tanima Tarafdar, Assistant Professor, RSC
- (vi) Mr. Santujit Chanda, Assistant Professor, RSC

Some of the crucial suggestions made during the meeting for the current course structure of **B.COM.(H)**, **RSC** especially with reference to B.Com.  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  semester are as follows -

- (i) Prof. Amrit Pal Singh suggested that the University should **implement NEP,2020** in the upcoming session i.e. from August, 2023. It was further suggested to introduce 22 credits point system equally for each semester course (balancing for 4 Years) in order to have parity and facilitate ease of movement for the students.
- (ii) A proposal was put forward to mention Honors/Specialization for certification of B.Com Course.
- (iii) It was insisted that in the paper **Human Resource Management** of B.Com 5<sup>th</sup> Semester topics related to performance appraisal and employee separation needs to be included.
- (iv) The content of unit 3 and unit 4 in the paper of Service Marketing of B.Com.5<sup>th</sup> semester needs to be reduced.
- (v) Amendments in the DSE Paper of Financial Statement Analysis of B.Com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester needs to be updated.
- (vi) Inclusion of the concept of Repo Rate in the DSE paper of Banking Law and Practices in B.com. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- (vii) In the paper Indirect Taxation of B.Com.6th Semester it has been suggested to include portions from Excise, Customs and GST as well.
- (viii) It has further been advised by Prof. Amrit Pal Singh to introduce hands on training for the SEC paper Investment in Stock Exchange of B.Com. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester wherein

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demo classes can be provided by the students in trading in order to make the classes reality based.

The discussion also included the following suggestions for the course structure of B.COM. (H) F & A,RSC -

- The Total Credit Points (TCP) for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters should be in even number. (i)
- (ii) Reduction of content in the syllabus of Legal Aspects of Business.
- In the syllabus of Banking and Insurance, the insurance part needs to be enhanced. (iii)
- More focus on topics like International Monetary System and Trading in Rupee needs (iv) to be made in International Finance of 5<sup>th</sup> semester.
- Service Marketing needs to be included in Principles of Marketing. Topics like Public Relations, Direct Marketing and the 7Ps of marketing needs to be included in the syllabus.
- (vi) The elements of PODSCORB i.e., Planning, Organizing, Directing, Staffing, Coordinating, Budgeting and Reporting needs to be included in the syllabus of Management Principles and Applications.

Topics like Role of Private parties in Rural economy and Contract farming should (vii) be included in the syllabus of Microfinance.


