PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING

Prof. (Dr.) Gitumono Konwar, Dean/Principal, Royal School of Nursing, RGU presided over the meeting.

1.1: Agenda: Welcoming the members of the Board of studies

The meeting commenced with the welcome address by Prof. Gitumoni Konwar, Dean/Principal, RSN. She extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Board of Studies.

1.2 (i) Agenda: To discuss and approve modified course structure of B. Sc. Nursing launched since 2018-19

Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar presented the restructured Syllabus of B.Sc. Nursing course given by statutory body Indian Nursing Council as per the RGU format since 2018-19 academic sessions in Royal School of Nursing, RGU. She also placed the core structure of the syllabus up to 4th year (final year) of B. Sc. Nursing. The inclusion of subjects as per the RGU norms and format has been highlighted like, Behavioural Science (1st year) from 2019-20 and in second year from 2018-19, Environmental Science (2nd Year) from 2019-20, Foreign Language (2nd year) from 2019-20 and Communicative English (2nd, from 2019-20) and 3rd Year B.Sc. Nursing, from 2020-21) and Middle Level Health Care Provider (MLHP) in 4th year B.Sc. Nursing.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved the syllabus of B.Sc. Nursing. However, Professor Kaberi Saikia suggested to distribute Middle level Health Care Provider course In Community Health Nursing-I (2nd year) and Community Health Nursing-II (4th year) instead of providing whole syllabus in 4th year B. Sc. Nursing. It has been decided to distribute the syllabus according to the suggestion and will be sending to her within 2 days.

1.2 (ii): Agenda: To discuss and approve detailed syllabi of first year, Second year B. Sc. Nursing and 3rd year B.Sc. Nursing

Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar gave a presentation and explained the detailed syllabi of first year, Second year and 3rd Year B.Sc. Nursing as per the RGU norms.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved the syllabus of B.Sc. Nursing. However, Professor Kaberi Saikia suggested to include related portions of theory and skill from Middle Level Health Care Provider course in Subject: Community Health Nursing-I in 2nd year B. Sc. Nursing with immediate effect from the present second year batch (2019-20). The Middle Level Health Care Provider course syllabus has a portion in Environmental science which is already included in RGU B. Sc. Nursing syllabus as a subject: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) in second year B.Sc. Nursing as per UGC guidelines.

1.2 (iii): Agenda: To discuss Academic Calendar of the School form August 2020 to Dec 2020.

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Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar placed the Academic Calendar of the School from August 2020 to Dec 2020. She has mentioned about the shifting of upcoming Academic session 2020-21 from October to September (Subjected to modification as per the current Pandemic Situation).

Resolutions: The BOS has given concurrence to the Academic Calendar as decided without any modification (Subjected to modification as per the current Pandemic Situation) to place in Academic Council Meeting for approval.

1.2 (iv): Agenda: To discuss and approve the master & clinical rotation plan and time table for all the three years of B. Sc. Nursing

Deliberations: Ms. Urmijyoti Deori presented the master & clinical rotation plan and time table for all the three years of B. Sc. Nursing for the Academic session 2019-20 and 2020-21 for Royal School of Nursing.

Resolutions: The BOS has given approval to the master & clinical rotation plan and time table for all the three years of B. Sc. Nursing for the Academic session 2019-20 and 2020-21 for Royal School of Nursing.

1.2 (v): Agenda: To discuss and approve revised Master & clinical rotation plan and time table for B. Sc. Nursing based on the current pandemic situation

Deliberations: Ms. Urmijyoti Deori presented the revised master & clinical rotation plan and time table for the 1st and 2nd year of B. Sc. Nursing for the academic session 2019-20 for Royal School of Nursing based on the current pandemic situation.

Resolutions: The BOS has given approval to the revised master & clinical rotation plan and time table for the 1st and 2nd years of B. Sc. Nursing for the academic session 2019-20 for Royal School of Nursing changes made based on the current pandemic situation. After discussion it has been resolved that the clinical experience of the students will be modified to the online mode as per necessity of the current situation based on circular by Indian Nursing Council.

1.3 Agenda: To place the decisions taken on Scheme of Examination

Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar presented the decisions taken on Scheme of Examination at Royal Global University according to INC Syllabus.

- Theory papers for University examination 100 marks/ paper out of which 25 internal assessments and 75 written paper. Environmental Science (2nd Year, B. Sc. Nursing) paper for University examination 100 marks/ paper out of which 25 internal assessment and 75 written paper.
- The Theory papers of RGU norms subjects like Behavioural Science (1st year), Foreign Language (2nd year) and Communicative English (2nd and 3rd Year B.Sc. Nursing) papers for University examination 100 marks/ paper out of which 30 internal assessment and 70 written paper. The evaluation criteria will remain applicable, i.e. separate passing in Internal Assessment and written paper is not required and out of 100 marks pass mark is 35.
- For practical papers, Nursing foundation & Medical Surgical Nursing-I, total 200 marks out of that 100 marks internal and 100 marks external or Practical examinations and Rest of the clinical subjects viz, Medical Surgical Nursing-II, Child Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Obstetrical and Gynaecological Nursing for total 100 marks out of that 50 internal and 50 Practical examination with external teachers.

She has pointed out the examination guideline given by Indian Nursing Council based on the current COVID19 pandemic situation.

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- All the sessional examination result would be used for internal assessment of the students.
- If lockdown continues and the student can't sit for the exam, then the OSCE with reduced skill station may be used for final Examination.
- Exam shall be conducted with maximum 2 hours and should be conducted batch wise.
- Promote the students to next year if they failed in any subject and have to appear in supplementary exams.
- Mid-term: June 3rd and to be conducted online if the students can't sit for written pen paper examination due to lockdown
- Pre-final exam - June 15th as per Academic calendar, and to be conducted pen and paper subjected to change to online based on the situation
- Final exam on the planned time as per the Academic Calendar from 7th September to 18th September, (subjected to change based on the current pandemic).

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved the Examination Scheme and examination details adopted based on the current pandemic.

1.4 Agenda: To place and the Internal assessment criteria for all the years of B. Sc. Nursing.

Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar presented the internal assessment criteria for all the years of B. Sc. Nursing.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved the internal assessment criteria for all the years of B. Sc. Nursing without any modifications.

1.5 Agenda: Practical Examinations Evaluation criteria

Deliberations: Prof. Gitumoni Konwar presented the Practical Examinations Evaluation criteria for all the years of B. Sc. Nursing.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved Practical Examinations Evaluation criteria as placed for the clinical subjects all the years of B. Sc. Nursing without any modifications.

Nursing which was already approved in 1st BOS meeting conducted on 19th May 2020, accordingly it was already included and implemented in the present batch syllabi.
- Research project should be carried out during internship.

Deliberations: Ms. Y. Renubala Devi presented the Syllabus and curriculum of B.Sc. Nursing course given by statutory body Indian Nursing Council as per the RGU format since 2018-19 academic sessions in Royal School of Nursing, RGU. She presented the allotted theory and practical hours and discussed regarding master & clinical rotation plan and time table for all the three years of B. Sc. Nursing for the Academic session 2021-22 for Royal School of Nursing. She also placed the core structure of the syllabus up to 4th year (final year) of B. Sc. Nursing.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved the syllabus and curriculum of B.Sc. Nursing. The master & clinical rotation plan and time table for the 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year B. Sc. Nursing were approved by the Board of Studies for the academic session 2021-2022 for Royal School of Nursing.

Deliberations: Mrs. Y. Renubala Devi presented the internal assessment criteria for both theory and practical paper. She placed the scheme of examination and pattern of question setting for 2nd Year, 3rd Year and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing final university examination for the Academic session 2021-22.

Resolutions: The BOS has given approval the internal assessment criteria, scheme of examination and pattern of question setting for 2nd Year, 3rd Year and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing final university examination for the academic session 2021-22. However, Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested:

- Internal assessment criteria for both theory and practical paper will be same as previous for the 2nd Year, 3rd Year and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing for the Academic session 2021-22.
- Midwifery and Obstetrical Nursing university final examination will be conducted in the 4th year for the 2019-2023 and 2020-2024 B.Sc Nursing Academic Batches.
- The subject code allotted by Royal Global University will be followed as previous for the 2nd Year, 3rd Year and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing for the Academic session 2021-22.

3 (i): **Agenda: To discuss and approve the detailed syllabi of the 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing of the new revised INC syllabus.**

Deliberations: Ms. Bhanita Barman presented the Syllabus and curriculum of 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing prescribed by statutory body Indian Nursing Council. She presented the theory and practical hours and discussed regarding master & clinical rotation plan of 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing for the academic session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.

Solutions: The Board of Studies approved the syllabus and curriculum of 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester according to INC. However,

- Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested to follow the Academic duration (weeks and hours) prescribed by Indian Nursing Council for 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing for the academic session 2022-2023.
- Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested to change and modify the Academic duration and master rotation plan of the 1st semester and 2nd semester B.Sc. Nursing from 21 weeks to 26 weeks for the academic session 2021-2022.
- Ms. Moonmoon Ahmed, suggested to propose and also take approval again for the Academic duration from the Academic Council of Royal Global University.

3 (ii): **Agenda: To discuss and approve the subject codes of the new revised INC syllabus.**

Deliberations: Ms. Bhanita Barman presented the subject codes for each subject of 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester, 4th semester, 5th semester, 6th semester, 7th semester and 8th semester prescribed by INC.

Solutions: The Board of Studies approved the subject codes of 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester, 4th semester, 5th semester, 6th semester, 7th semester and 8th semester. However, Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested:

• Subject code prescribed by INC for the nursing subjects should be followed and reflected in the certificate but RGU allotted subjects in each semester, RGU provided code will be used. The Board of Studies mentioned few private universities name where the subjects codes are followed as prescribed by INC so that the students will not face any problem in future. The mentioned universities are 1. The Assam Down Town university, 2. Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Uttar Pradesh, 3. Shri Guru Ram Rai University, Dehradun, 4. ERA University, Lucknow, 5. Swami Rama Himalayan University, Dehradun and 6. Swami Vivekananda Subharti University, Uttar Pradesh.

3 (iii): **Agenda: To discuss and approve the date of semester end (odd and even) examination**

Deliberations: Ms. Bhanita Barman presented the Academic duration (weeks and hours) prescribed by Indian Nursing Council for 1st semester, 2nd semester, 3rd semester and 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing mentioning the duration of examination weeks allotted by INC.

Solutions: The Board of Studies did not approve the the date of semester end (odd and even) examination which

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was provided by the RGU Academic calendar. Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested to maintain the academic duration and to finalise again the the date of semester end (odd and even) examination of B.Sc. Nursing obeying the INC guidelines.

However, Ms. Moonmoon Ahmed, suggested to propose and also take approval again for the date of semester end (odd and even) examination from the Academic Council of Royal Global University.

1.3 (iv): Agenda: To discuss the Academic calendar of Royal School of Nursing for the year 2021-2022

Deliberations: Prof.(Dr.) Kaberi Saikia displayed the 2nd revised Tentative Academic calendar of Royal Global university for the year 2021-2022. She highlighted the date of orientation for both odd and even semester with that the date of end semester (odd and even) examination.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies did not approve the date of orientation for both odd and even semester for B.Sc. Nursing. Prof. (Dr.) Hemeswari Bhuyan suggested to maintain the academic duration and to finalise again the Academic calendar of Royal School of Nursing. However, Ms. Moonmoon Ahmed, suggested to propose and also take approval again from the Academic Council of Royal Global University to prepare the Academic calendar of Royal School of Nursing.

1.3(v): Agenda: To discuss regarding the back subject clearance of each semester.

Deliberations: Ms. Bhanita Barman presented the guidelines mentioned by INC highlighting the points like-

- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for fifth semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for seventh semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examination before appearing for final year examination.
- The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years.

Resolutions: The Board of Studies approved and suggested to follow all the Guidelines mentioned by INC for semester batches of B.Sc. Nursing.


1.3(vi): Agenda: To place and approve the scheme of examination and pattern of question setting for end semester (odd and even) examinations of B.Sc. Nursing as per INC Guidelines for the academic session 2022-2023.

Deliberations: Ms. Bhanita Barman presented the guidelines mentioned by INC regarding the scheme of examination and pattern of question setting for end semester examinations for all the semesters of B.Sc. Nursing.

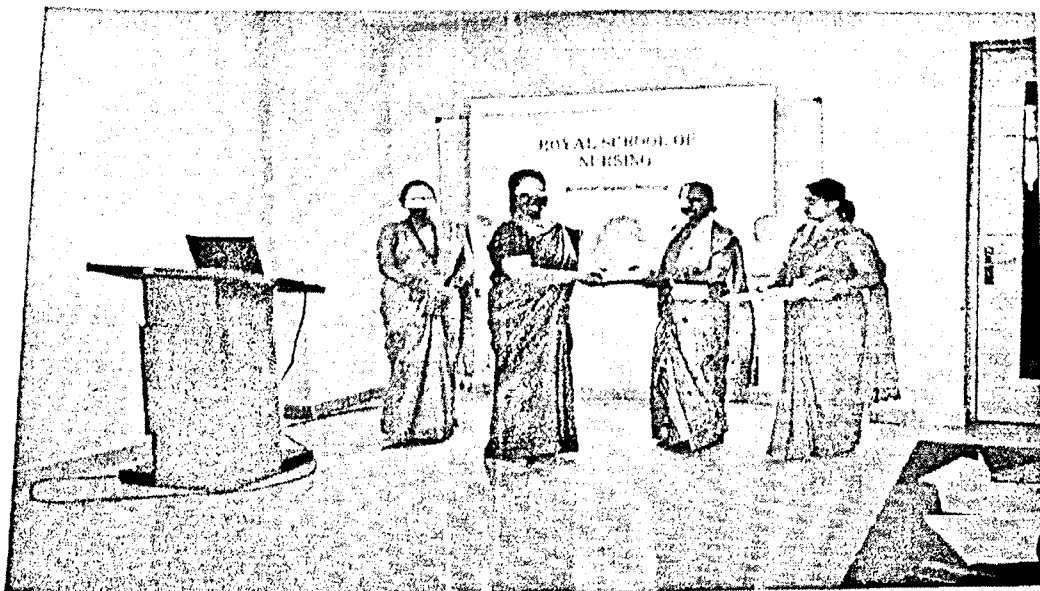

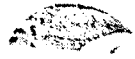

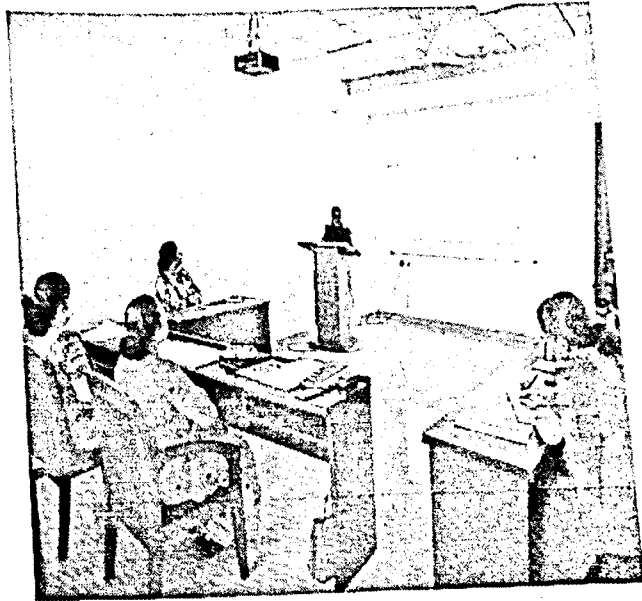
