



Policy relating to Fee concession etc. for students winning laurels in fields of literary/ cultural/ sports/others.

To promote student participation in inter-university/zonal*/national/international level academics/co-curricular/sports events, where student representing the University/ State/ Country, RGU has a policy for providing financial assistance/ sponsoring some of the expenses incurred by the students for participating in such events.

To further motivate the students, the University now proposes to provide Special Fee Concession to the students winning laurels in the fields of literary/ cultural/ sports/ others, in the following categories -

- a) inter-university events at national level (Category A)
- b) representing state/UT at national level events (Category B)
- c) inter-university events at international level (Category C)
- d) representing country at international level events (Category D)

The proposed policy is as follows -

Note:

- i. The University Authorities/Officers reserves the right to award this fee concession on case to case basis. The decision of University Authorities/Officers in this regard shall be final.
- ii. The fee concession offered shall be adjusted with the fee payable next year by the student/s. In case of final year students, the amount relevant to the concession shall be refunded to the student.
- iii. The student/s winning any laurel, as specified above, shall be recognized at the next event of the University (preferably orientation/re-orientation programme) with a certificate, along with announcement of the percentage of fee concession received.
- iv. The events recognized by AIU/Relevant departments of state and central Governments/other competent authorities will only be considered for the fee concession policy.
- v. The student must have participated in the event mentioned above as a bonafide student of RGU.
- vi. In case student is availing any other kind of scholarship from the University, they will not be eligible for this additional fee concession/rebate. However, in case the monetary benefit under this fee concession policy is higher than the scholarship, then this policy shall supersede the scholarship policy/amount for that academic year and the student shall be the beneficiary of this policy.
- vii. The Fee Concession will only be applicable on annual course fee. Concession will not be applicable on other fee like Hostel fee, Transport fee etc. will not be given concession.

* Zonal means North/South/East/West/Central or any other zone region where minimum of 4 states of India form a zone/region.
