INTRODUCTION

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is an internal mechanism established in higher educational institutions in India as per the guidelines provided by the University Grants Commission (UGC). It plays a crucial role in monitoring, evaluating, and enhancing the quality of education and overall performance of the institution.

The IQAC aims to ensure continuous improvement in the functioning of institutions. It functions as a nodal agency for channeling efforts towards quality enhancement and sustenance.

Objectives of IQAC:

The primary objectives of the IQAC, as outlined by the UGC, include:

Development and application of quality benchmarks: The IQAC establishes and maintains quality benchmarks for various academic and administrative activities of the institution.

Promotion of quality culture: It promotes a culture of quality improvement by organizing workshops, seminars, and other activities to sensitize faculty, staff, and students towards the significance of quality enhancement in higher education.

Documentation and dissemination of good practices: The IQAC encourages and facilitates the documentation of best practices followed by the institution, which can be shared with other institutions for their reference.

Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment: It helps in the adoption of learner-centric teaching methods, curriculum development, and assessment practices to ensure holistic development and active engagement of students.

Monitoring quality parameters: The IQAC monitors various quality parameters, such as student performance, faculty development, infrastructure facilities, research output, and feedback mechanisms, to identify areas of improvement.

Functions of IQAC:

The IQAC performs several functions to achieve the afore-mentioned objectives. Some of the key functions as per UGC guidelines are:

Development and maintenance of quality assurance processes: The IQAC develops and implements processes for quality assurance in all aspects of institutional functioning, including teaching-learning, research, governance, and administration.

Preparation of Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR): The IQAC prepares the AQAR, which is a yearly report highlighting the institution's quality enhancement activities, progress made in the implementation of quality benchmarks, and future plans for quality improvement.

Coordination of quality-related activities: It acts as a coordinating body to ensure the effective implementation of quality-related initiatives, including accreditation and assessment exercises.

Organization of workshops, seminars, and training programs: The IQAC organizes capacity-building programs for faculty, staff, and students to enhance their understanding of quality issues, teaching methodologies, research practices, and administrative procedures.

Collection and analysis of feedback: It collects feedback from various stakeholders, including students, alumni, employers, and parents, to assess the quality of programs and services offered by the institution and initiates appropriate measures for improvement.

Institutionalizing best practices: The IQAC facilitates the identification and institutionalization of best practices to enhance the quality of education and administrative processes.

Collaboration and networking: It promotes collaboration and networking with other institutions, agencies, and stakeholders involved in quality assurance in higher education to share experiences, learn from each other, and adopt best practices.

These functions collectively contribute to the continuous improvement and sustenance of quality in higher education institutions as per the UGC guidelines.

Members of the IQAC:

The composition of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in a university, as per the University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines, typically includes the following members:

Chairperson: The Vice-Chancellor or the Rector of the university usually acts as the Chairperson of the IQAC. They provide overall guidance and leadership to the cell.

Director/ Coordinator: A senior faculty member designated as the Director/ Coordinator of the IQAC is responsible for day-to-day coordination and implementation of quality assurance activities.

Nominee from Management/Administration: A representative from the university's management or administration, such as a member of the executive council or a senior administrative officer, is included in the IQAC.

- **Teachers:** A few senior faculty members representing different departments or disciplines are nominated to be part of the IQAC. These members should have experience in quality-related matters and a keen interest in academic and administrative affairs.
- **Experts from Outside the University:** The IQAC may include experts from outside the university who have expertise in quality assurance, accreditation processes, or higher education. These experts provide an external perspective and valuable insights.
- **Local Society Representatives/Stakeholders:** To ensure the participation of local community and stakeholders, the IQAC may include representatives from the local society,

industry, employers, or alumni. Their inputs contribute to aligning the institution's activities with societal needs.

- **Student Representatives:** The IQAC should have representation from the student community. Student representatives, typically from postgraduate courses or research programs, are nominated to provide insights into student-related matters.
- **Administrative Staff:** A representative from the administrative staff, such as the registrar or a senior administrative officer, is included in the IQAC to address administrative aspects related to quality assurance.

It's important to note that the exact composition of the IQAC may vary from institution to institution, and universities have the flexibility to include additional members based on their specific requirements. The UGC guidelines provide a general framework to ensure representation from various stakeholders and expertise in quality assurance.



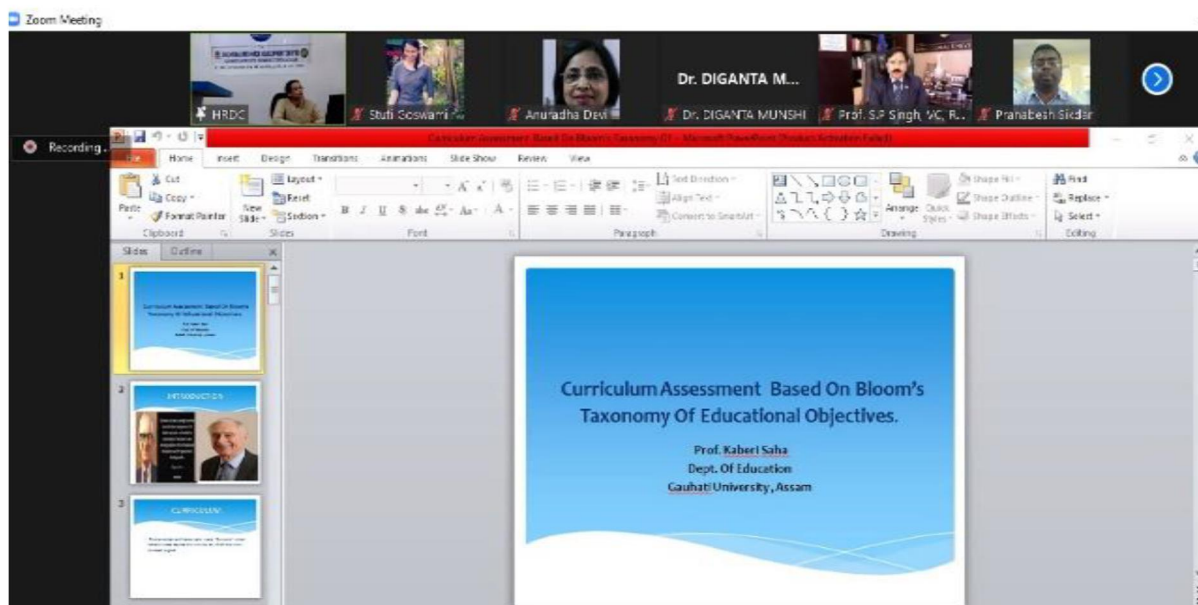
INTERNAL BENCHMARKING THROUGH ASSESSMENT & ACCREDITATION

The webinar began with the Welcome Speech delivered by Prof. (Dr.) Anuradha Devi, Coordinator, IQAC. In her welcome address, Prof. Devi highlighted the importance of Bloom’s Taxonomy in curriculum design in shaping the future of education. Hon’ble Vice Chancellor and Chairperson IQAC, Prof. (Dr.) S.P. Singh has spoken on his address about the need of faculty refresher courses based on the theme of webinar. The other eminent guest who addressed at the webinar was Prof. (Dr.) Alak Kr. Buragohain, Chairperson (Academics), Dr. Diganta Munshi, Registrar, RGU who talked about various pedagogy related to the theme of webinar. 3. Academic Bank of Credits (ABCs)

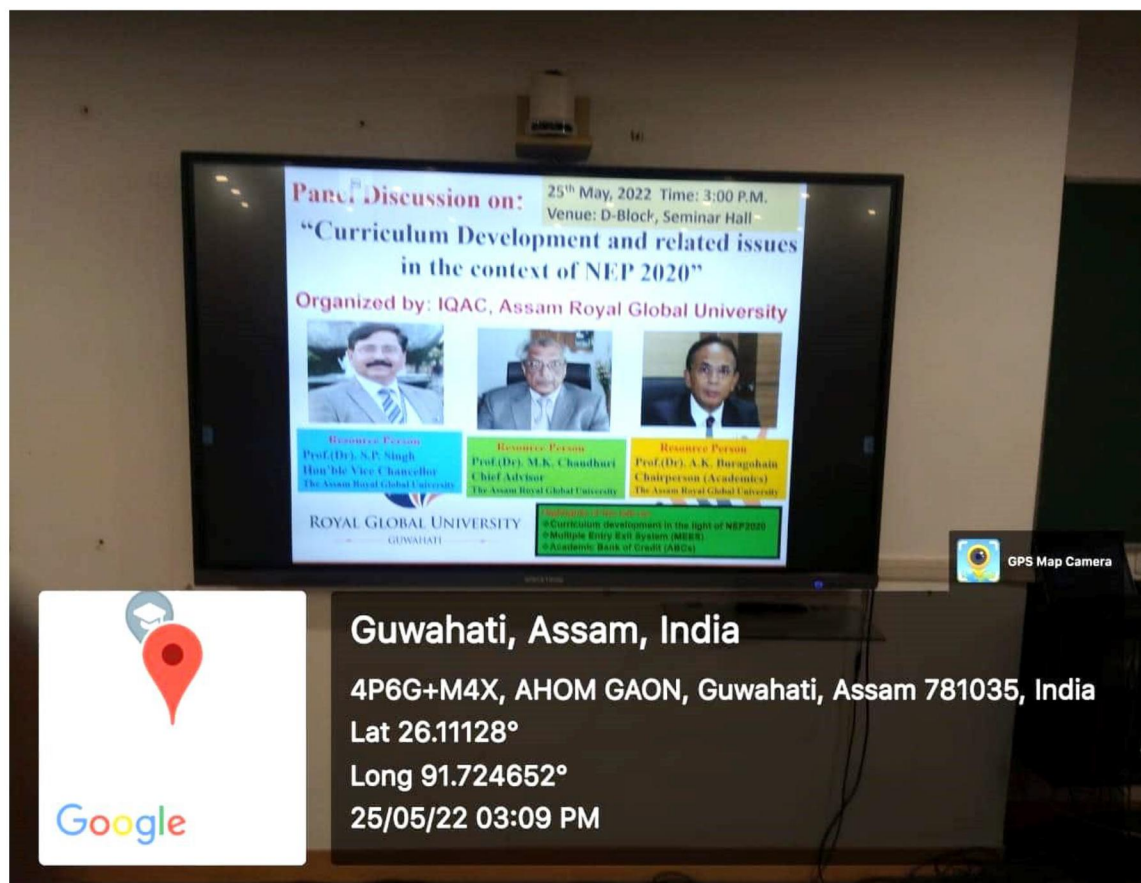

The panel also acknowledged the challenges associated with implementing the new curriculum and highlighted the importance of teacher training and capacity building. Overall, the discussion highlighted the potential of NEP 2020 to bring about a paradigm shift in the Indian education system and nurture learners who are well-prepared for the challenges of the 21st century.

The resource persons of the Panel discussions were:

The discussion was held amongst the Senior Professors, Head of Departments, Coordinators, IQAC members and NAAC Steering committee.



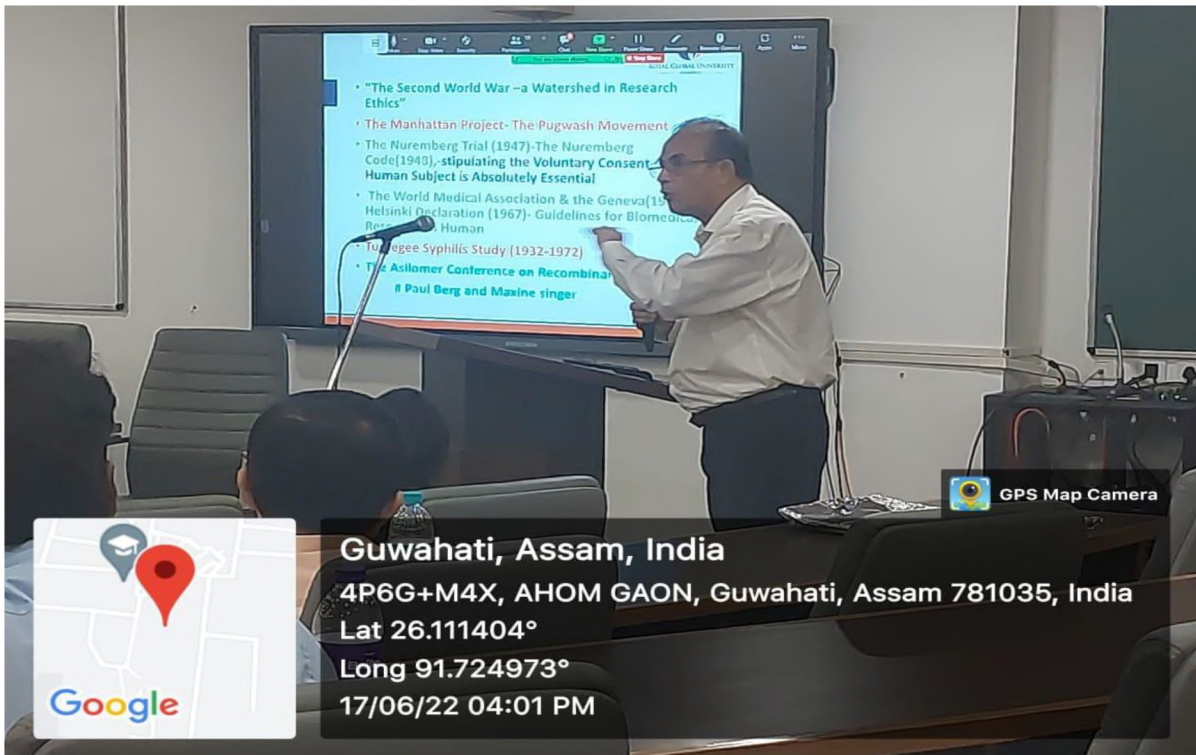
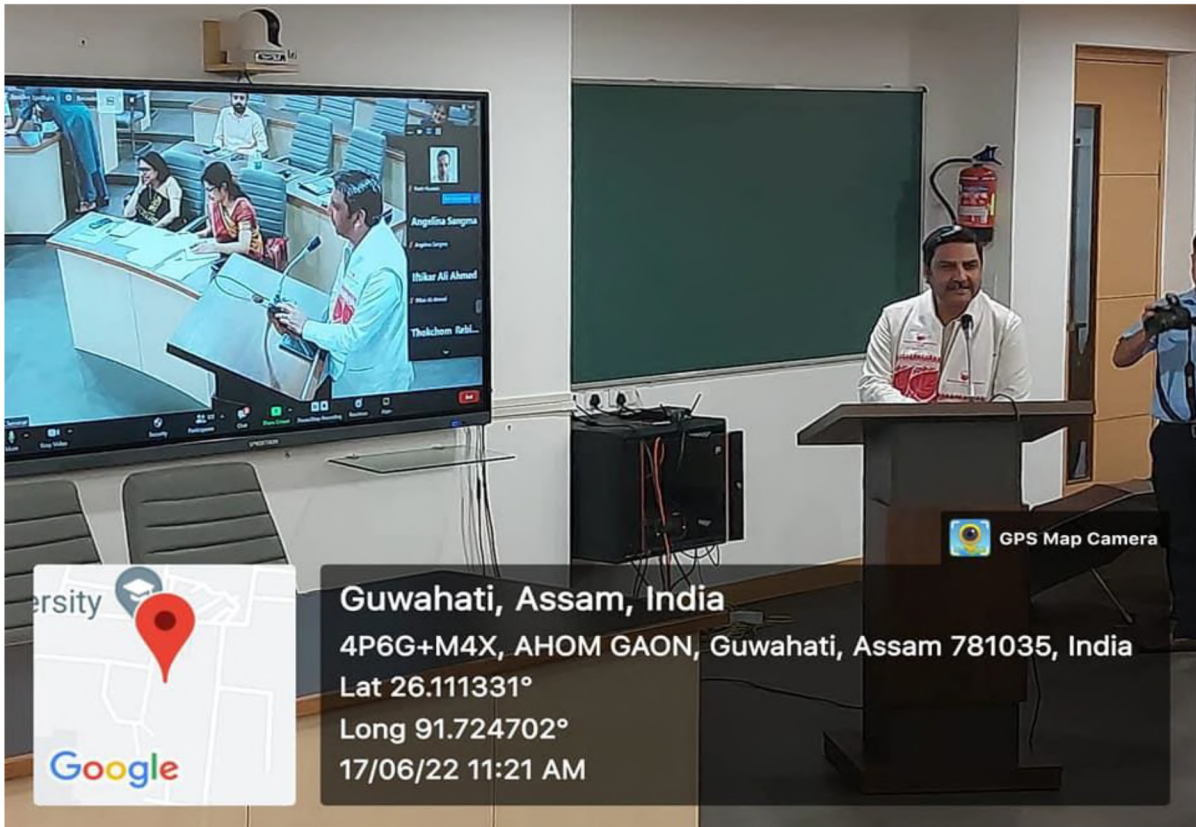


SEMINAR ON “FOCUS TOWARDS QUALITY RESEARCH”

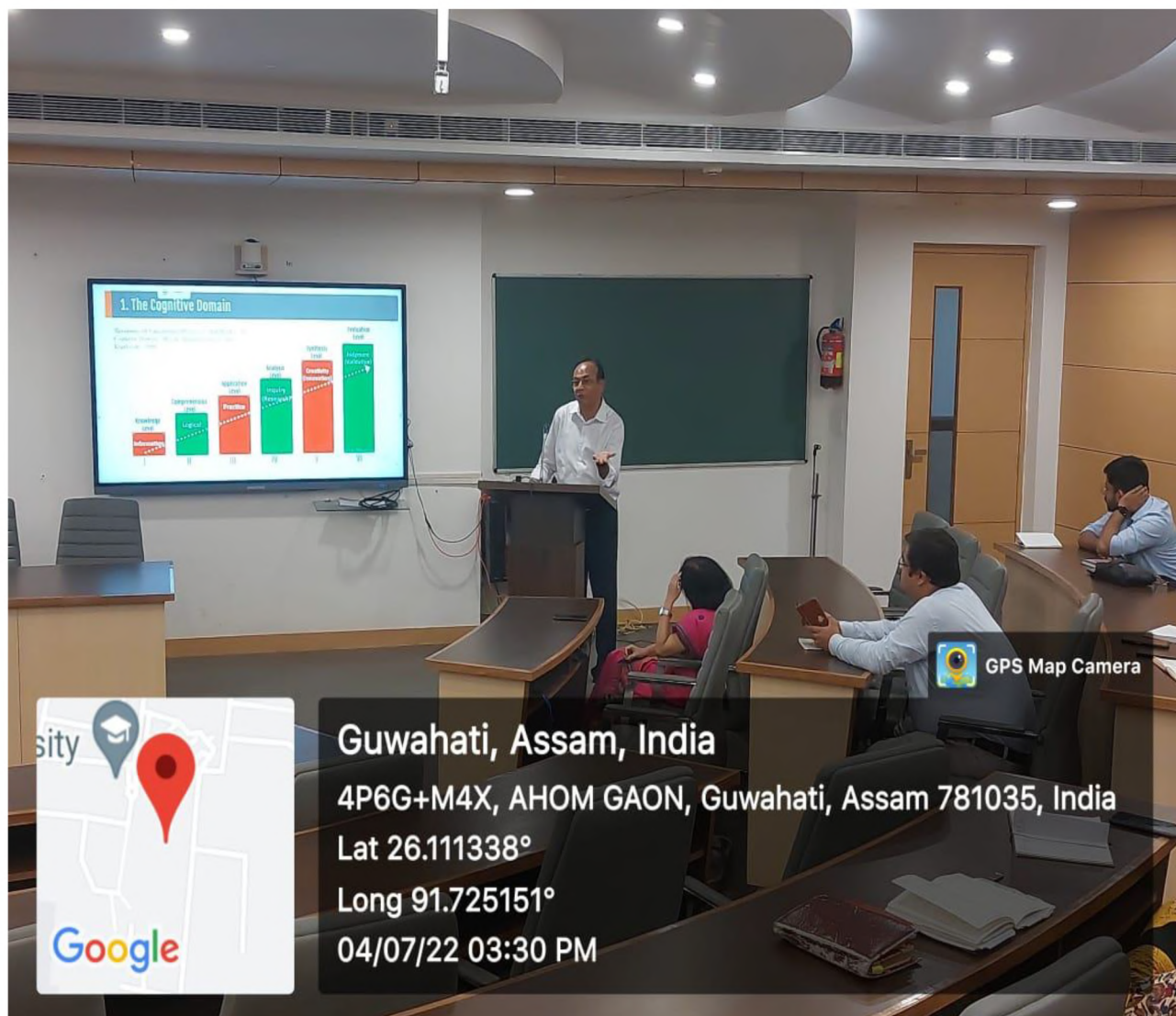




LECTURE DISCUSSION ON LOCF

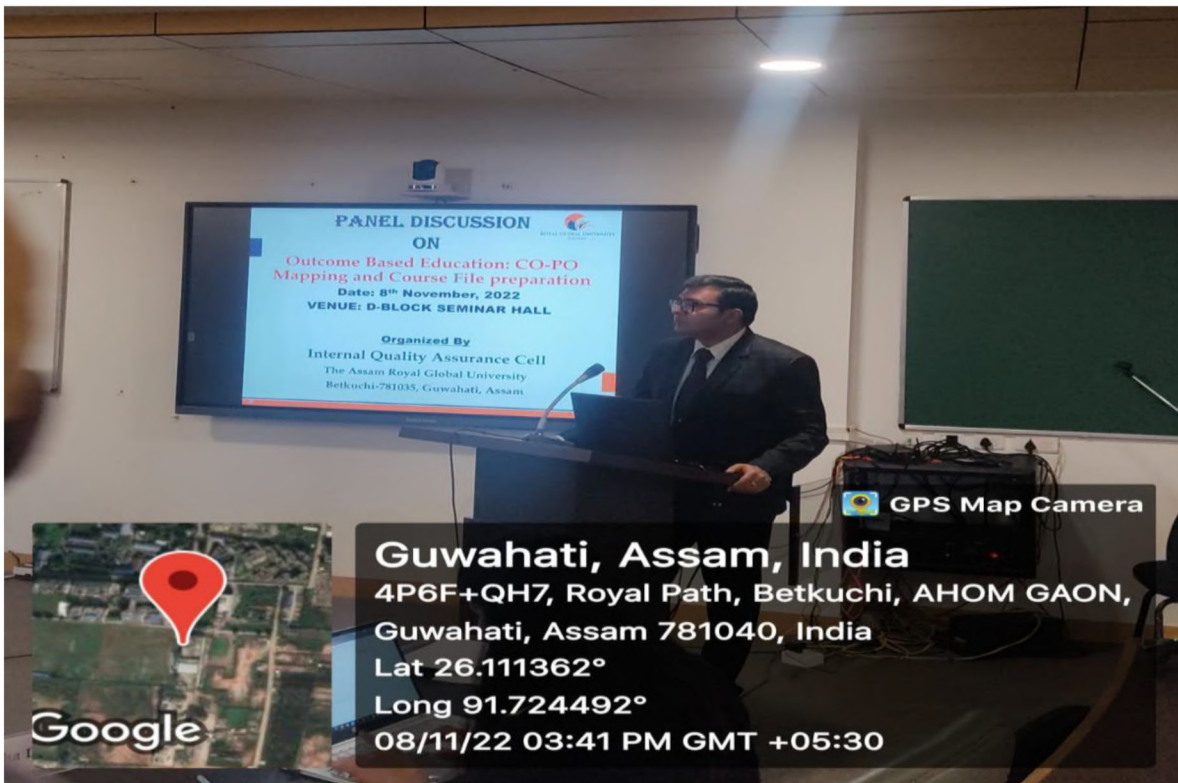


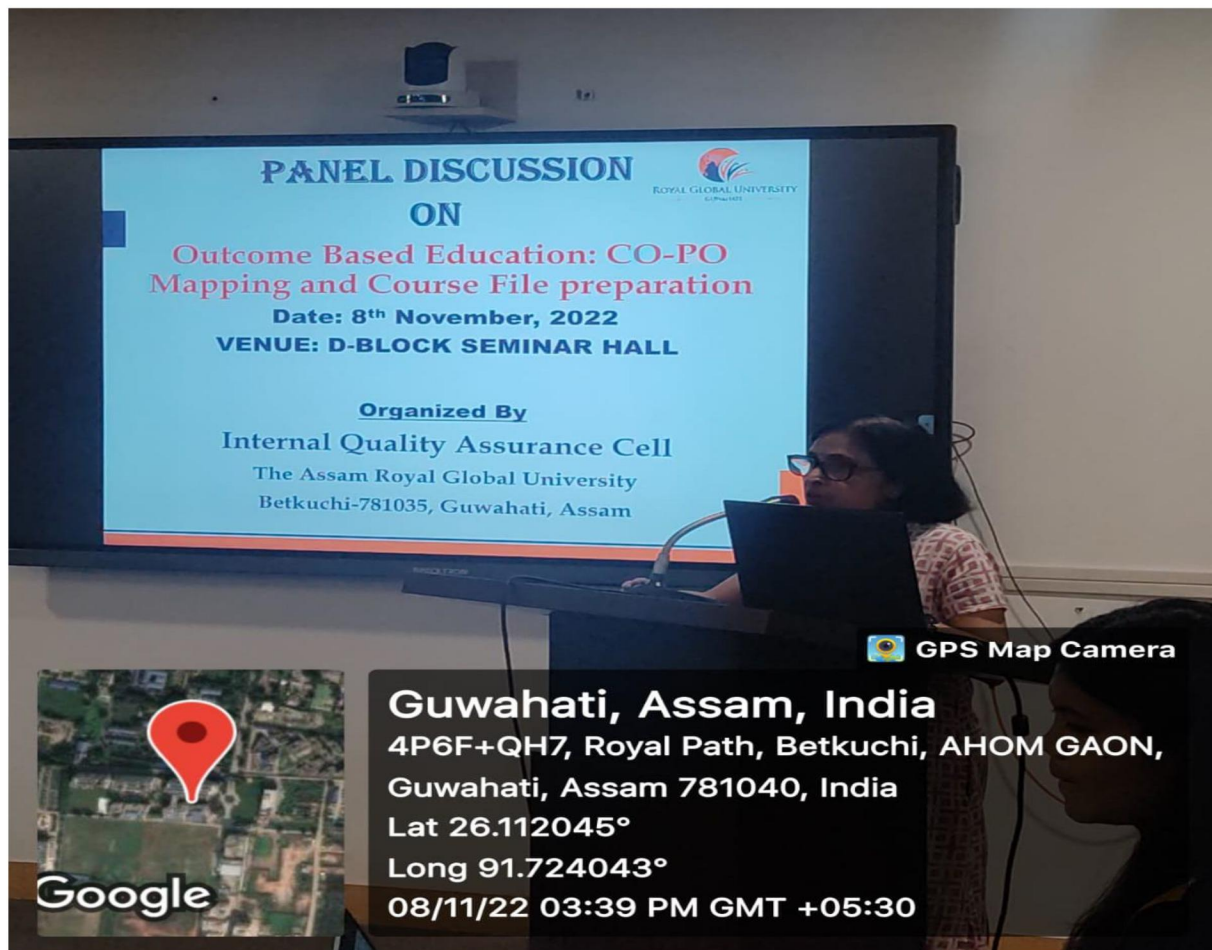


PANEL DISCUSSION ON “OUTCOME BASED EDUCATION: CO-PO MAPPING AND COURSE FILE PREPARATION”

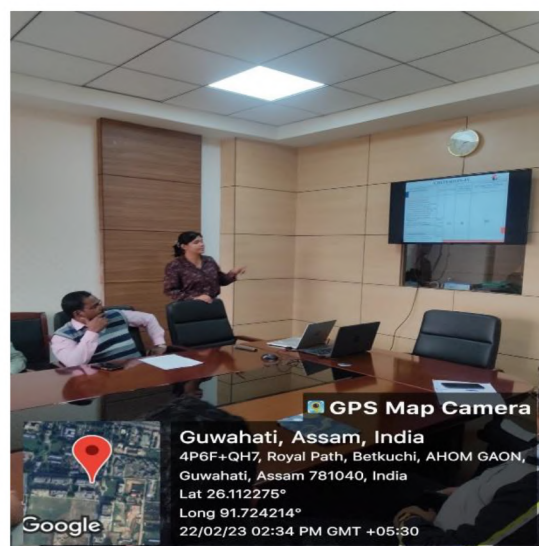
