



Two students from the department of Zoology, B.Sc. 2nd semester were recommended for their career counseling needs by Ms. Sangeeta Biswas (faculty coordinator for mentor- mentee interactions) to Mr. Robin Kalita through Miss Joyeeta Banerjee (*Assistant Professor Department of Social Work*).

The students reported to Mr. Kalita's chamber on Friday, 17th of March 2023 at 12:30 pm along with Ms. Sangeeta Biswas. Mr. Kalita interacted with the students for an hour. During the said hour the interaction started with the students introducing themselves (educational background, family background). The students were then asked about their career aspirations, their strengths and weakness, their previous attempts at pursuing their goals. Mr. Kalita patiently took note of everything to understand their current situation and then discussed the possible measures that could be taken in order to aid them.

After due deliberation he suggested that Ms. Aaysha continue her preparation of CAT and that she should also try for GMAT exams and prepare for the Young Leaders Program to improve her chances to apply to Management schools while doing her best at the course she is currently enrolled in.
