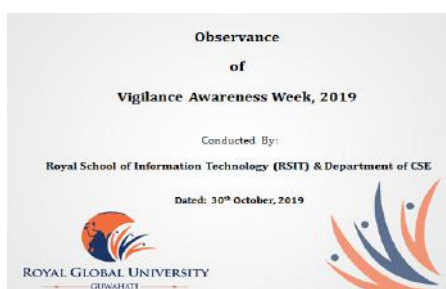


INNOVATION DAY

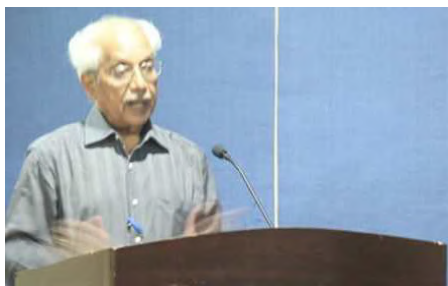

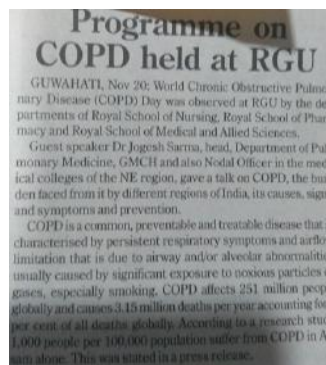
