6th October: Royal School of Commerce and the Department of Philosophy, DHSK College organized a webinar on 'Curriculum Development on Perspective of NEP 2020'.

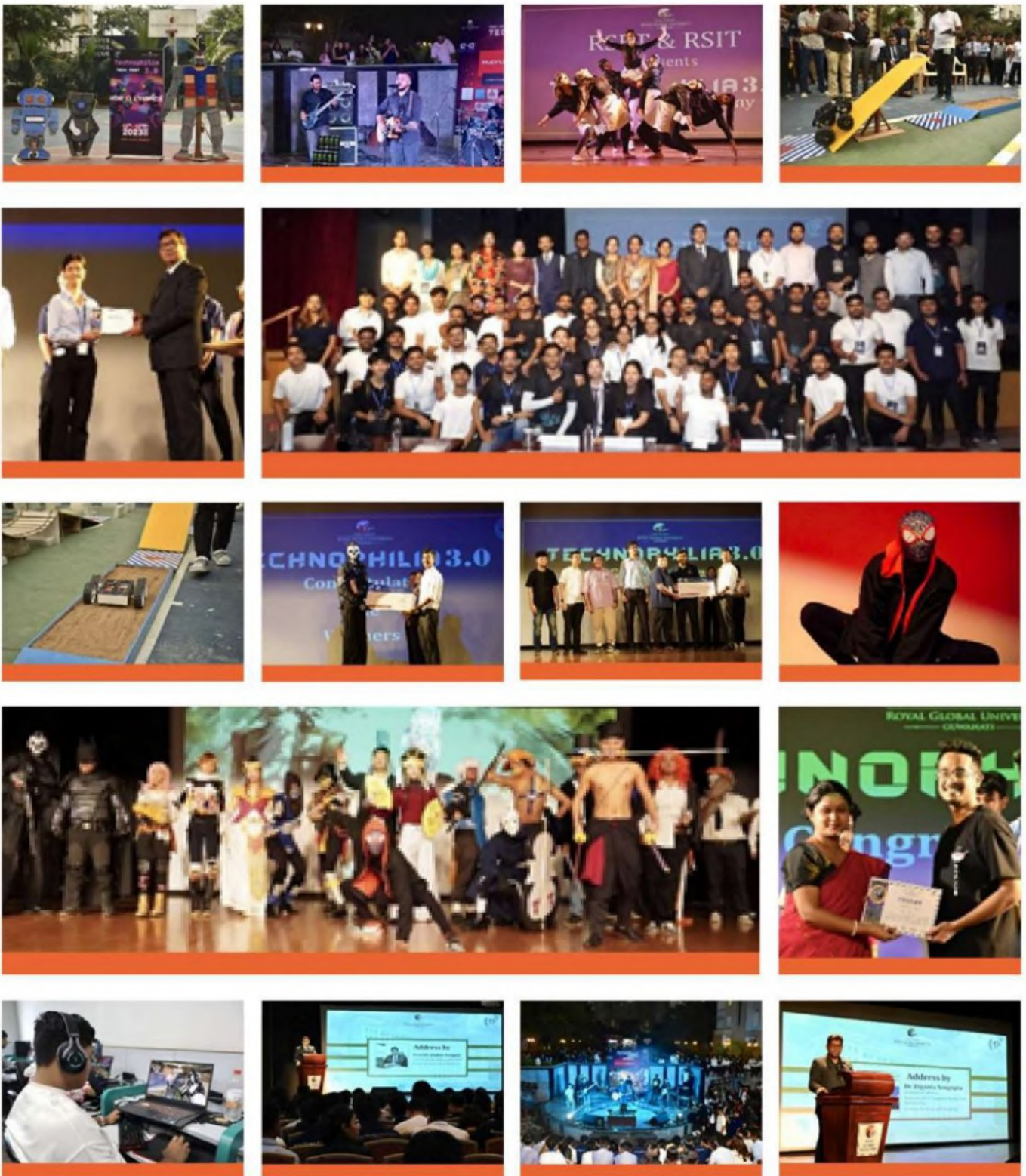

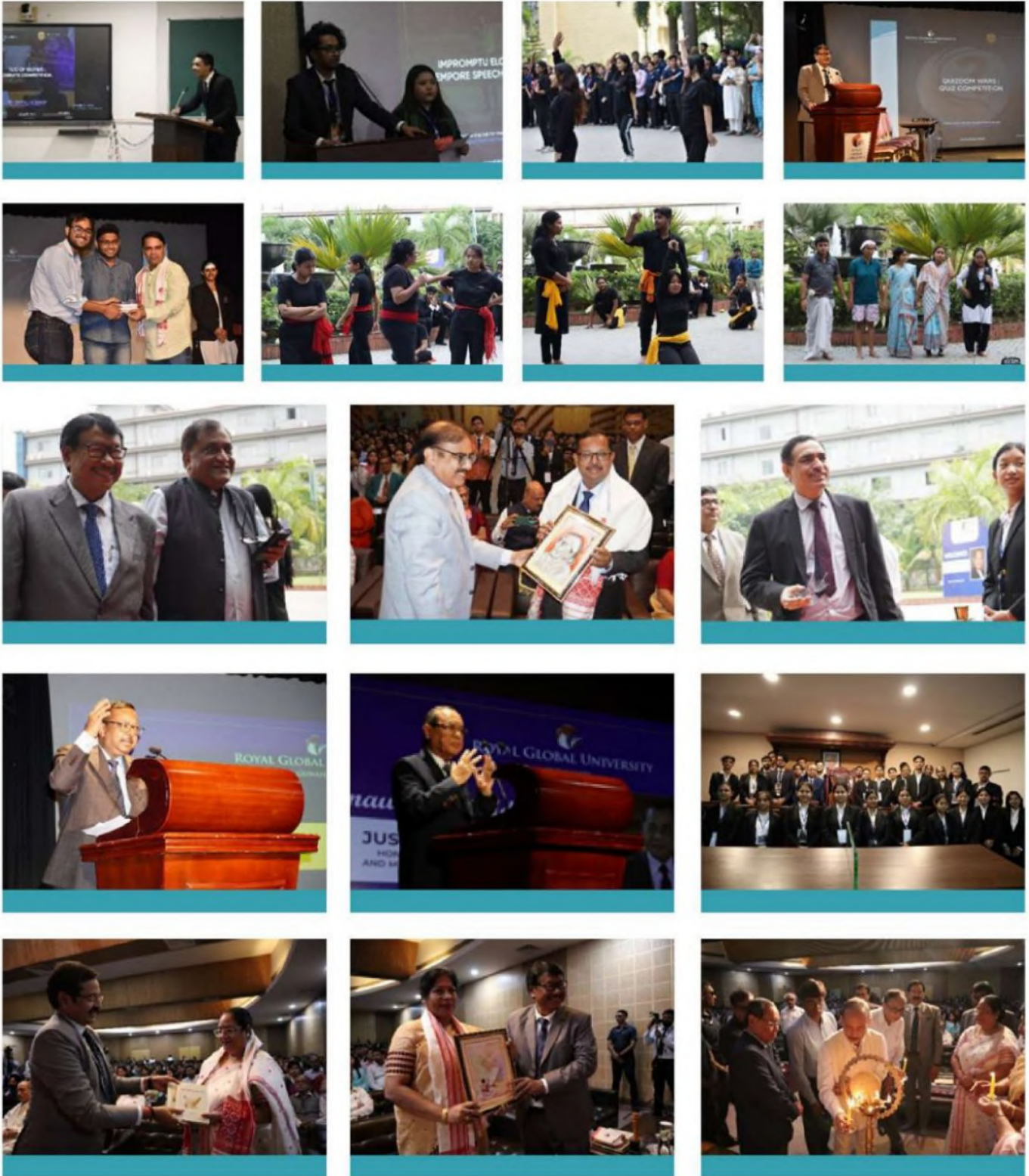

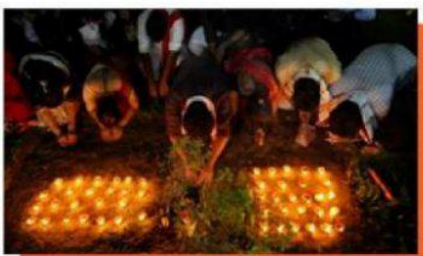


16th October: 'World Anesthesia Day' was celebrated by the Department of Operation Theatre Technology on the theme 'Anesthesia and Cancer Care'.

18th October: Kati Bihu was celebrated at Royal Global University.

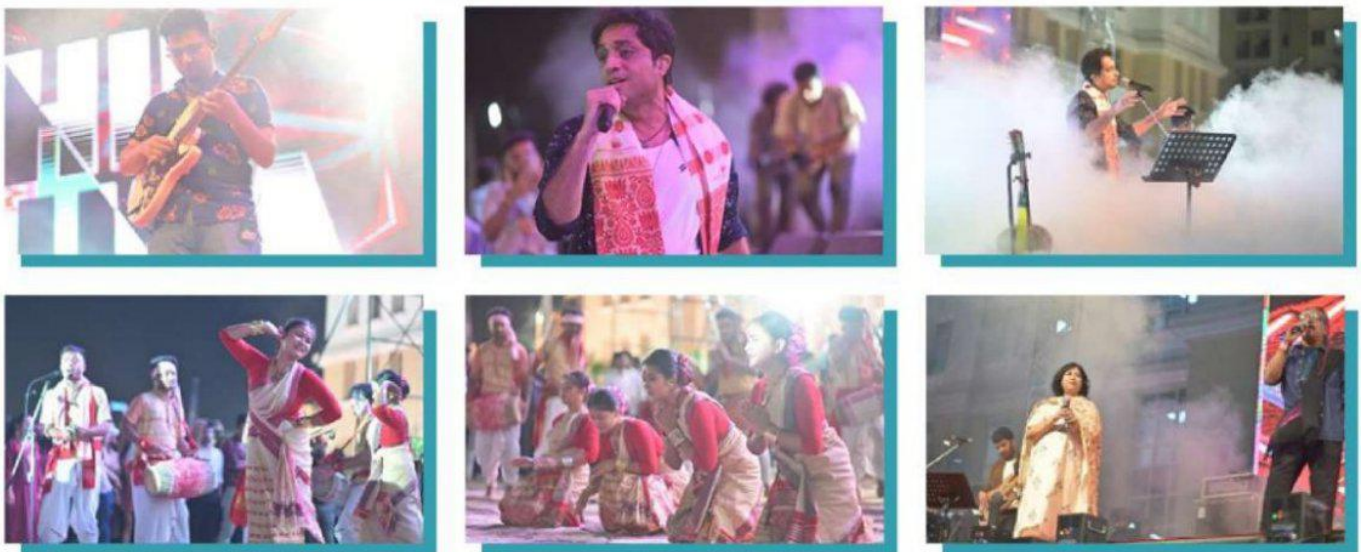

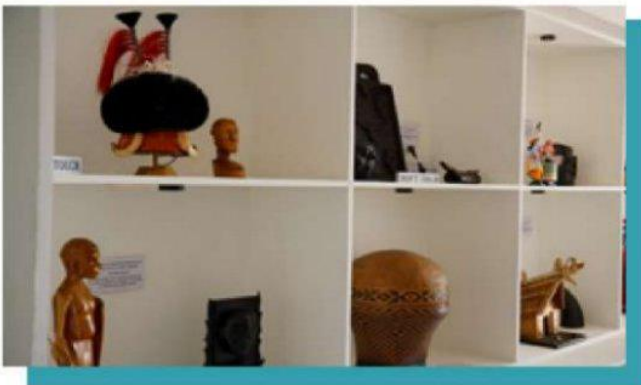
