Mr. Chandra Mohan Patowary, Minister of Environment and Forests, Act East Policy Affairs, Welfare of Minorities and Shri. Bimal Bora, Minister of Industries and Commerce and Public Enterprises, Cultural Affairs also attended the occasion.

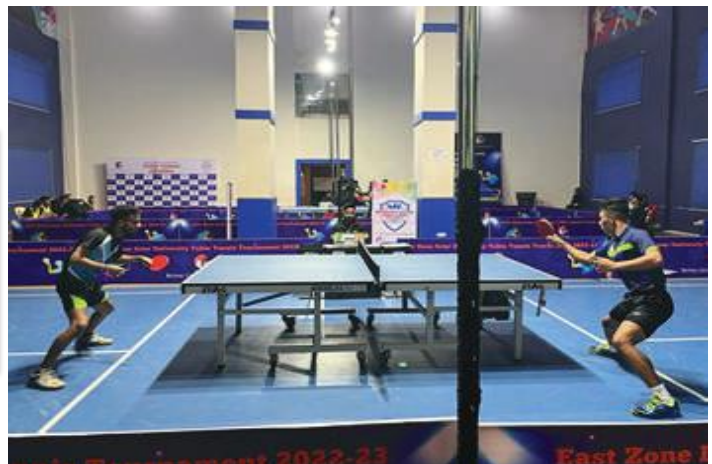


SPORTS EVENTS

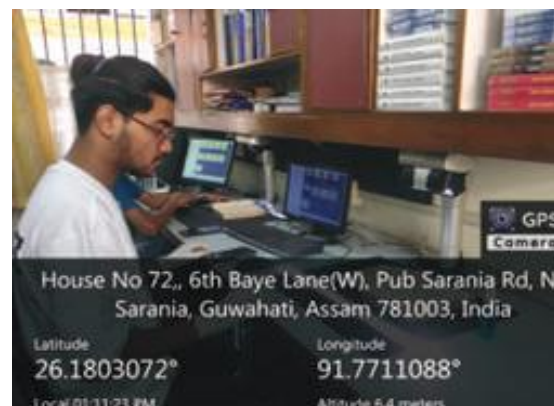
