## Research support for the UG/PG students (2022-2023)

To imbibe research interest among undergraduate and postgraduate students, RGU implemented a policy of providing financial support to the students under the supervision of the faculty members. In the academic year, 2022-2023, RGU provided one-year research grants to 83 students under the guidance of 33 faculty members, with a cumulative funding of Rs. 11,11,173.00 (rupees eleven lakh eleven thousand one hundred and seventy-three only). The projects culminated in successful completions, with outputs being published in peer-reviewed journals and conference proceedings. This initiative aims to encourage students to engage in research and prepare them to pursue research-based careers in their future endeavours.

The funding may cover:

- Basic laboratory consumables and reagents.
- Travel expenses for sample collection, data curation, research presentation, etc.
- Conference fees to present the findings

Overall, this university-funded research initiative offers valuable opportunities for students to participate in real-time research and make meaningful contributions to their chosen academic disciplines. This engagement not only allows students to apply theoretical knowledge in practical settings but also enhances their critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Such projects often serve as motivational tools, encouraging students to pursue deeper exploration within their fields of interest.
