A student availing **100% Royal Merit Scholarship** is required to the Caution money of Rs. 10000/- (refundable) only and those availing Royal Merit Scholarship in 50% or 25% categories are required to pay the remaining percentage of fee for the 1st semester/year of his/her programme of study along with the Admission Fee, Registration Fee and Caution money (refundable) of Rs. 10000/- only at the time of admission.
- In case a student, availing Royal Merit - On Admission Scholarship, wishes to avail hostel/ transportation facilities, he/she will have to pay the full hostel/ transportation fees as prescribed for other students.
