Organized by Royal Global University, Guwahati

Association of Indian Universities (AIU) is an Apex Inter-University Organization which was formed to bring together all the universities in India on a common platform through a coordinating body to protect the students as well as the universities. It was formed on March 23,1925 and initially was named as Inter-University Board

(IUB)of India. Later under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, on September 29, 1967, it was renamed as Association of Indian Universities (AIU) in 1973.

AIU act as a National Sports Promotion Organization (NSPO) for promoting sports among Member-Universities and maintain the standards in sports and to enhance participation of university sports at National and International championship competitions and make efforts to improvise upon the sports infrastructure in the universities.

The Association of Indian Universities (AIU) has given Royal Global University, Guwahati the opportunity to host and conduct the East Zone Inter University Women Badminton Championship at the university campus from 17th December to 19th December 2021. RGU had received a good number of registrations from 49 universities out of which 33 Universities across East Zone had participated in the tournament. A total of 132 players and 70 coaches and managers participated in the tournament. On 17th December, 9: 00A.M the fixtures were drawn in front of all the coaches and managers of all the participating universities.

The inauguration ceremony started at 3:30P.M which was attended by Assam Special Director General of Police (Law & Order) Sri. G.P Singh, Chancellor of Royal Global University (RGU) Dr. A.K. Pansari, Joint Commissioner of Guwahati Police Sri. Partha Sarathi Mahanta, Vice Chancellor of Royal Global University Prof. (Dr.) S.P. Singh, Executive Vice President of RGU Sri. Ankur Pansari, RGU Chairperson (Academics) Prof. Alak Kumar Buragohain, RGU Registrar Dr. Diganta Munshi, players and members of different universities, students, and faculty members of RGU. After the inauguration ceremony the East Zone Inter University Women Badminton Championship started and it continued till 19th December,2021. It was a three-day event.

For the smooth conduct of the tournament officials of Assam Badminton Association were roped in to participate as chief referee, deputy referee, match controller and technical experts. During the event proper the tournament was organized following all Covid-19 protocols.

The accommodation and food for the participating athletes, coaches and managers were arranged in the centrally air-conditioned hostels within the university campus.

The event came to an end on 19th December where Ranchi University was the winner of the tournament, Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur secured the 2nd position, Pt. Association of Indian Universities (AIU) is an Apex Inter-University Organization which was formed to bring together all the universities in India on a common platform through a coordinating body to protect the students as well as the universities. It was formed on March 23,1925 and initially was named as Inter-University Board(IUB)of India. Later under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, on September 29, 1967, it was renamed as Association of Indian Universities (AIU) in 1973.

AIU act as a National Sports Promotion Organization (NSPO) for promoting sports among Member-Universities and maintain the standards in sports and to enhance participation of university sports at National and International championship competitions and make efforts to improvise upon the sports infrastructure in the universities.

The Association of Indian Universities (AIU) has given Royal Global University, Guwahati the opportunity to host and conduct the first ever All India Inter University Women Baseball Tournament in the Northeast region. It kick started on 6th January 2022 in the premises of the university. RGU had received a good number of registrations from 35 universities out of which 20 Universities across India participated in the tournament.

A total of 320 players and 40 coaches and managers participated in the tournament. On 6th January along with players and members from different universities, the inauguration function was attended by Assam Revenue and Disaster Management Department Principal Secretary Avinash Joshi, Commissioner of Guwahati Police Harmeet Singh, Chancellor of Royal Global University Dr. A K Pansari, RGU Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) SP Singh, Executive Vice President of RGU Ankur Pansari, RGU Registrar Dr. Diganta Munshi, students, and faculty members of the university.

The All India Inter University Women Baseball Tournament started on 6th Jan,2022 and it continued till 10th Jan,2022. It was a five-days event.

For the smooth conduct of the tournament officials of Assam Baseball and Softball Association officials were roped in for functioning as umpires and for other requirements of the tournament. The event was proper was organized following all Covid-19 protocols.
